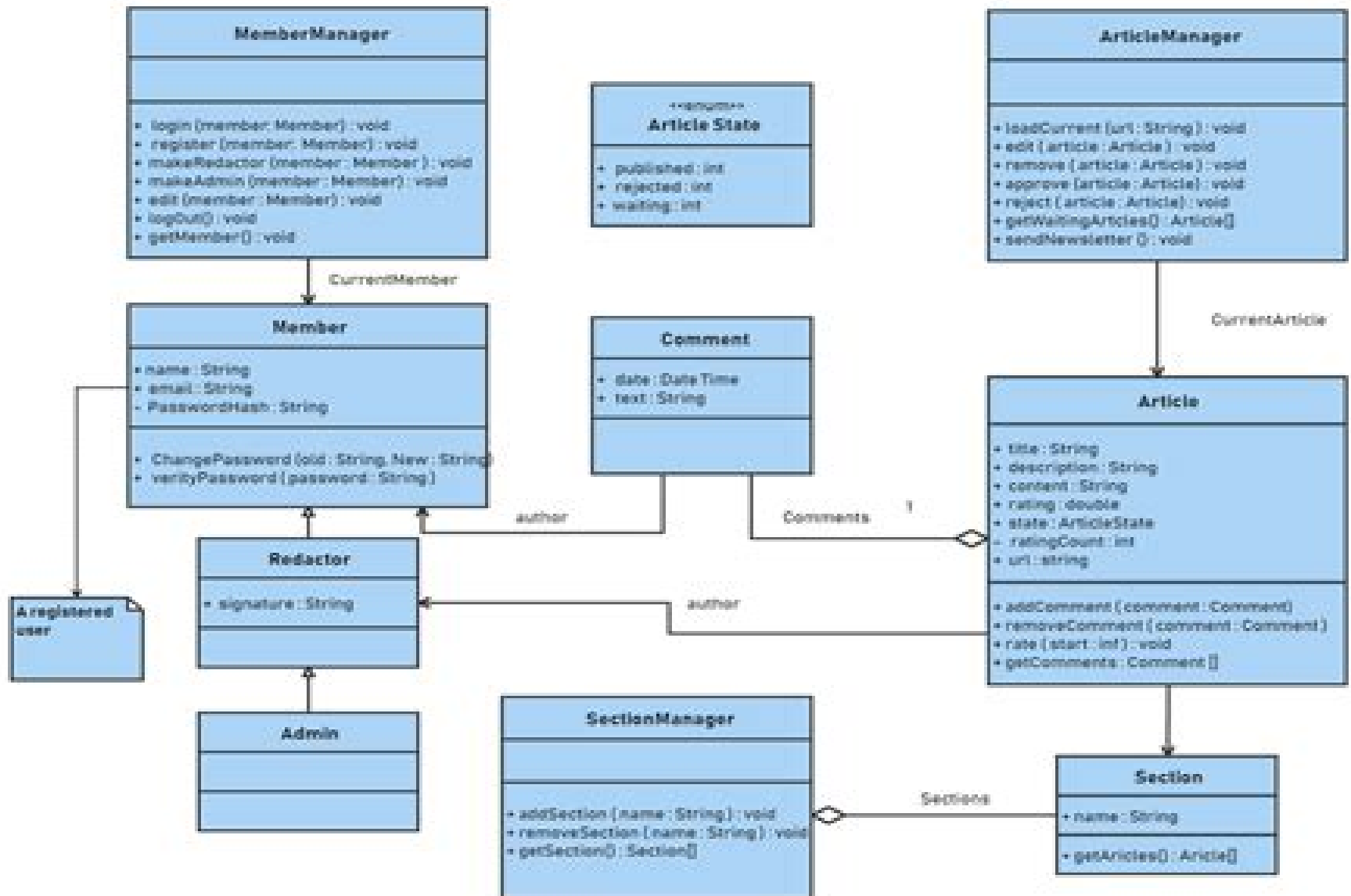


Domain Model UML Class Diagram
