Sample Literary Essay #1 With a Lens on Character

In Ruby the Copycat by Peggy Rathman, Ruby is a new student at school who wants to fit in so badly that she tries to make friends with a classmate named Angela by copying everything Angela does. Miss Hart is Ruby's teacher. From the very beginning Miss Hart notices Ruby needs help fitting in and starts giving her support. As a character Miss Hart is very important to me because of the support she shows Ruby.

One place in this book when Miss Hart proves she is supportive of Ruby is after Ruby recites a poem that is just like Angela's poem. Angela reads her poem from her paper first and Ruby goes next. The text says, "What a coincidence,' murmured Miss Hart." The illustration shows Miss Hart simply putting her head in her hand. In my opinion this proves that Miss Hart is supportive because she could have embarrassed Ruby in front of the rest of the class by asking to see the poem on her paper. Instead Miss Hart doesn't ask for the poem, knowing that Ruby doesn't have it, so that the rest of the class will not make fun of her.
