#### Sample Examination Questions: Solutions

- (a) The degree of a polynomial f(x) in k[x], deg(f), is defined as follows:
  - If f(x) = 0, the zero polynomial, so that all coefficients in f(x) are equal to 0, then the degree of f(x) is -∞: deg(0) = -∞.
  - If f(x) ≠ 0, so that f(x) has the form a<sub>0</sub> + a<sub>1</sub>x + · · · + a<sub>n</sub>x<sup>n</sup>, for a<sub>0</sub>, a<sub>1</sub>, · · · , a<sub>n</sub> in k, and a<sub>n</sub> ≠ 0, then the degree of f(x) is n: deg(f) = n, i.e. the degree of f(x) is the largest non-negative integer i for which a<sub>i</sub> is not equal to 0.
  - (b) Given a(x), b(x) ∈ k[x], where b(x) ≠ 0, let us first show that there exist q(x), r(x) ∈ k[x] such that a(x) = q(x)b(x) + r(x) and deg(r) < deg(b).</p>

To do so, we may start with any q'(x) and r'(x) that satisfy a(x) = q'(x)b(x) + r'(x), e.g. we may start with q'(x) = 0 and r'(x) = a(x):

$$a(x) = 0 \cdot b(x) + a(x)$$

If the condition deg(r') < deg(b) holds, then we may immediately choose q(x) to be 0 and r(x) to be a(x).

Otherwise, if the condition deg(r') < deg(b) does not hold, then we may (perhaps repeatedly) apply the following:

Suppose that  $deg(r') \ge deg(b)$ . We may express r'(x) and b(x) as the following polynomials with coefficients in the field k:

$$r'(x) = r_n x^n + r_{n-1} x^{n-1} + \dots + r_1 x + r_0$$
 for  $r_n \neq 0$   
 $b(x) = b_m x^m + b_{m-1} x^{m-1} + \dots + b_1 x + b_0$  for  $b_m \neq 0$ 

Note that the presence of a non-zero coefficient in b(x) follows from the assumption that  $b(x) \neq 0$ , while the presence of a non-zero coefficient in r'(x) follows, subsequently, from the assumption that  $deg(r') \geq deg(b)$ ; from this, we also obtain  $n \geq m$ .

Then, we may obtain a "new" remainder of smaller degree by considering  $r_nb_m^{-1}x^{n-m}b(x)$  (note that, since  $b_m \neq 0$ , and the coefficients are in a field k, the element  $b_m$  is invertible, so that we may use  $b_m^{-1}$ , as we do below):
