

History of Newspapers

Newspapers have been an efficient and effective way to transfer news from one place to another. A variety of papers have existed since the first early civilizations and have continued to evolve over the centuries to the newspapers that we know today. The printing press was invented in the 15th and helped to expedite the dissemination of new thoughts and topics. The printing press allowed for text to be reused and expedited the process of printing multiple newspapers.

1450

In the 16th century in England began to print treatises, print advertisements, business notices, and satirical papers in the streets and taverns. They also featured the first papers in print headbands and talked about national events and crimes.

1640

In 1687 the first newspaper published in the United States, the first English newspaper that no one could be prosecuted for criticizing the government or violating the laws.

In 1827 the first newspaper published in African America was published and called Freedom's Journal. The purpose was to give readers a voice and opportunity to report on things that were important to them and from their perspective.

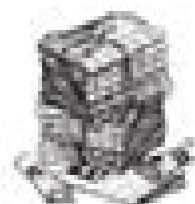

In 1914 Walter Dill Scott established the first newspaper chain in 1914 and was publishing newspapers across including the Cleveland Press and Cleveland Post. He founded, bought, merged, and sold papers in order to develop his large chain.

From the 18th to the 19th century, there were handwritten newsletters, began writing the first version of news reports called the Dutch. These publications covered politics, news, scientific, and other understandings.

1566

In 1605 the earliest version of the modern newspaper appeared in Venice. These were handwritten news sheets, called news or gazettes, that circulated through major trade cities and were seen as the way to England.



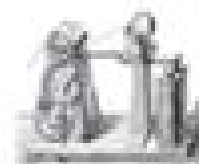

1783

The first daily newspaper in America was published in 1783 and called the Pennsylvania Evening Post. 3 other days after 17 months, however it stopped and first daily newspaper returned. By 1801 there were just nearly daily newspapers around the country.

1843

The creation of the telegraph led to the news across the first telegraphed Press being founded in 1843. Newspapers allowed the news coverage to be more national and across news boundaries across.

Hansen, Nora Paul, 2017 News coverage is often described as the first draft of history From the publication in 1690 of the first American newspaper *Publick Occurrences* to the latest tweet news has been disseminated to inform its audience about what is going on in the world But the preservation of news content has had its technological legal and organizational challenges Over the centuries as new means of finding producing and distributing news were developed the methods used to ensure future generations access changed and new challenges for news content preservation arose This book covers the history of news preservation or lack thereof the decisions that helped ensure or doom its preservation and the unique preservation issues that each new form of media brought All but one copy of *Publick Occurrences* were destroyed by decree The wood pulp based newsprint used for later newspapers crumbled to dust Early microfilm disintegrates to acid and decades of microfilmed newspapers have already dissolved in their storage drawers Early radio and television newscasts were rarely captured and when they were the technological formats for accessing the tapes are long superseded Sounds and images stored on audio and videotapes fade and become unreadable The early years of web publication by news organizations were lost by changes in publishing platforms and a false security that everything on the Internet lives forever In 50 or 100 years what will we be able to retrieve from today's news output How will we tell the story of this time and place Will we have better access to news produced in 1816 than news produced in 2016 These are some of the questions *Future Proofing the News* aims to answer *Communities of Journalism* David Paul Nord, 2001 Widely acknowledged as one of our most insightful commentators on the history of journalism in the United States David Paul Nord offers a lively and wide ranging discussion of journalism as a vital component of community In settings ranging from the religion infused towns of colonial America to the rapidly expanding urban metropolises of the late nineteenth century Nord explores the cultural work of the press **A History of American Magazines, Volume V: 1905-1930** Frank Luther Mott, 1968-01-02 In 1939 Frank Luther Mott received a Pulitzer Prize for Volumes II and III of his *History of American Magazines* In 1958 he was awarded the Bancroft Prize for Volume IV He was at work on Volume V of the projected six volume history when he died in October 1964 He had at that time written the sketches of the twenty one magazines that appear in this volume These magazines flourished during the period 1905-1930 but their biographies are continued throughout their entire lifespan in the case of the ten still published to recent years Mott's daughter Mildred Mott Wedel has prepared this volume for publication and provided notes on changes since her father's death No one has attempted to write the general historical chapters the author provided in the earlier volumes but which were not yet written for this last volume A delightful autobiographical essay by the author has been included and there is a detailed cumulative index to the entire set of this monumental work The period 1905-1930 witnessed the most flamboyant and fruitful literary activity that had yet occurred in America In his sketches Mott traces the editorial

partnership of H L Mencken and George Jean Nathan first on The Smart Set and then in the pages of The American Mercury He treats The New Republic the liberal magazine founded in 1914 by Herbert Croly and Willard Straight the conservative Freeman and Better Homes and Gardens the first magazine to achieve a circulation of one million without the aid of fiction or fashions Other giants of magazine history are here we see serious shaggy solid pragmatic self contained Henry Luce propel a national magazine called Time toward its remarkable prosperity In addition to those already mentioned the reader will find accounts of The Midland The South Atlantic Quarterly The Little Review Poetry The Fugitive Everybody s Appleton s Booklovers Magazine Current History Editor Publisher The Golden Book Magazine Good Housekeeping Hampton s Broadway Magazine House Beautiful Success and The Yale Review
