Kegley, Krzysztof Piotr Skowroński, 2013 This collection of essays focuses on the roles that coercion and persuasion should play in contemporary democratic political systems or societies A number of the authors advocate new approaches to this question offering various critiques of the dominant classical liberalism views of political justification freedom tolerance and the political subject A major concern is with the conversational character of democracy Given the problematic and ambiguous status of the many differences present in contemporary society the authors seek to alert us to the danger that an emphasis on reasonable consensus will conceal exclusion in practice of some contending positions The voices of vulnerable peoples can be unconsciously or even deliberately silenced by various institutional processes and operating procedures and a strong media influence can change the tenor of conversations and even lead to deception To counter these factors a number of the essays in differing ways urge the fostering of local community conversations or democratic agoras so that democratic debate and conversation might maintain the vitality necessary to a strong democratic system

Critique of Political Decolonization Bernard Forjwuor, 2023-05-24 What is political independence? As a political act, what was it sanctioned to accomplish? Is formal colonialism over or a condition in the present, albeit mutated and evolved? In *Critique of Political Decolonization*, Bernard Forjwuor challenges what in normative scholarship has become a persistent conflation of two different concepts: political decolonization and political independence. This scholarly volume is an antinormative and critical refutation of the decolonial accomplishment of political independence or self-determination in Ghana. He argues that political independence is insufficiently a decolonial claim because it is framed within the context of a country where a permanent colonial settlement was never deemed necessary for the consolidation of future colonial political obligations. So while territorial dissolution was politically engineered by Ghanaians, the colonial merely reconstitutes itself in different legal and ideological forms. Forjwuor offers new methodological, theoretical and conceptual approaches to engaging the questions of colonialism, political independence, political decolonization, justice and freedom and constructs multiple conceptual bridges between traditional disciplinary fields of inquiry including politics, history, law, African studies, economic history, critical theory and philosophy and political theory.
