depend on the tactical situation the injuries sustained by the casualty the knowledge and skills of the first responder and the medical equipment at hand In contrast to a hospital Emergency Department setting where the patient IS the mission on the battlefield care of casualties sustained is only PART of the mission TCCC recognizes this fact and structures its guidelines to accomplish three primary goals 1 Treat the casualty 2 Prevent additional casualties 3 Complete the mission In thinking about the management of combat casualties it is helpful to divide care into three distinct phases each with its own characteristics and limitations *FIELD MEDICAL SERVICE TECHNICIAN (FMST) - 2021* United States Marine Corps,2020-12-31
