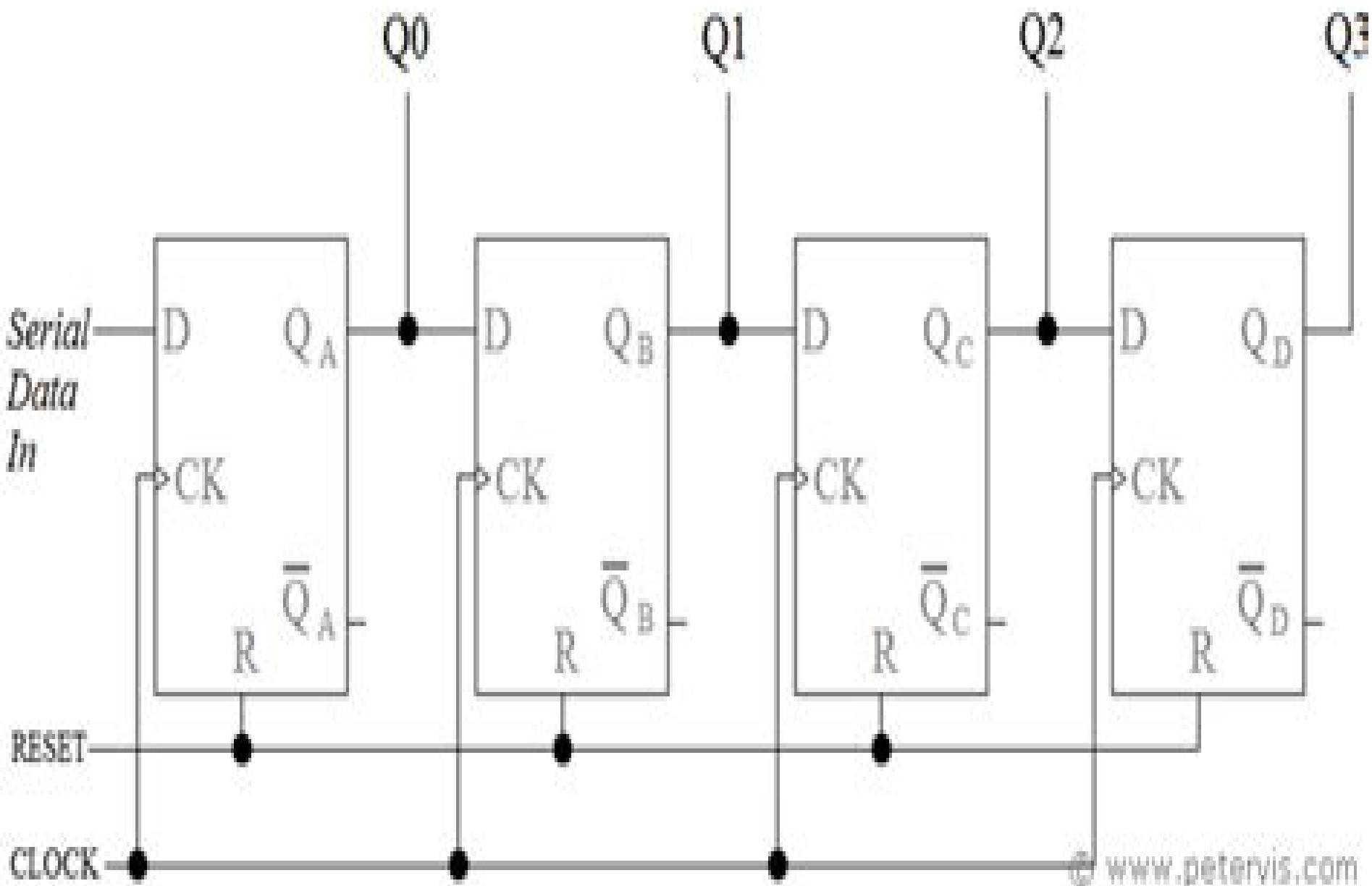

Digital VLSI Design with Verilog John Williams, 2008-06-06 Verilog and its usage has come a long way since its original invention in the mid 80s by Phil Moorby. At the time the average design size was around ten thousand gates and simulation to validate the design was its primary usage. But between then and now designs have increased dramatically in size and automatic logic synthesis from RTL has become the standard design flow for most designs. Indeed the language has evolved and been re-standardized too. Over the years many books have been written about Verilog. My own co-authored with Phil Moorby had the goal of defining the language and its usage providing examples along the way. It has been updated with five new editions as the language and its usage evolved. However this new book takes a very different and unique view. That of the designer. John Michael Williams has a long history of working and teaching in the field of IC and ASIC design. He brings an in-depth presentation of Verilog and how to use it with logic synthesis tools. No other Verilog book has dealt with this topic as deeply as he has. If you need to learn Verilog and get up to speed quickly to use it for synthesis this book is for you. It is sectioned around a set of lessons including presentation and explanation of new concepts and approaches to design along with lab sessions.
