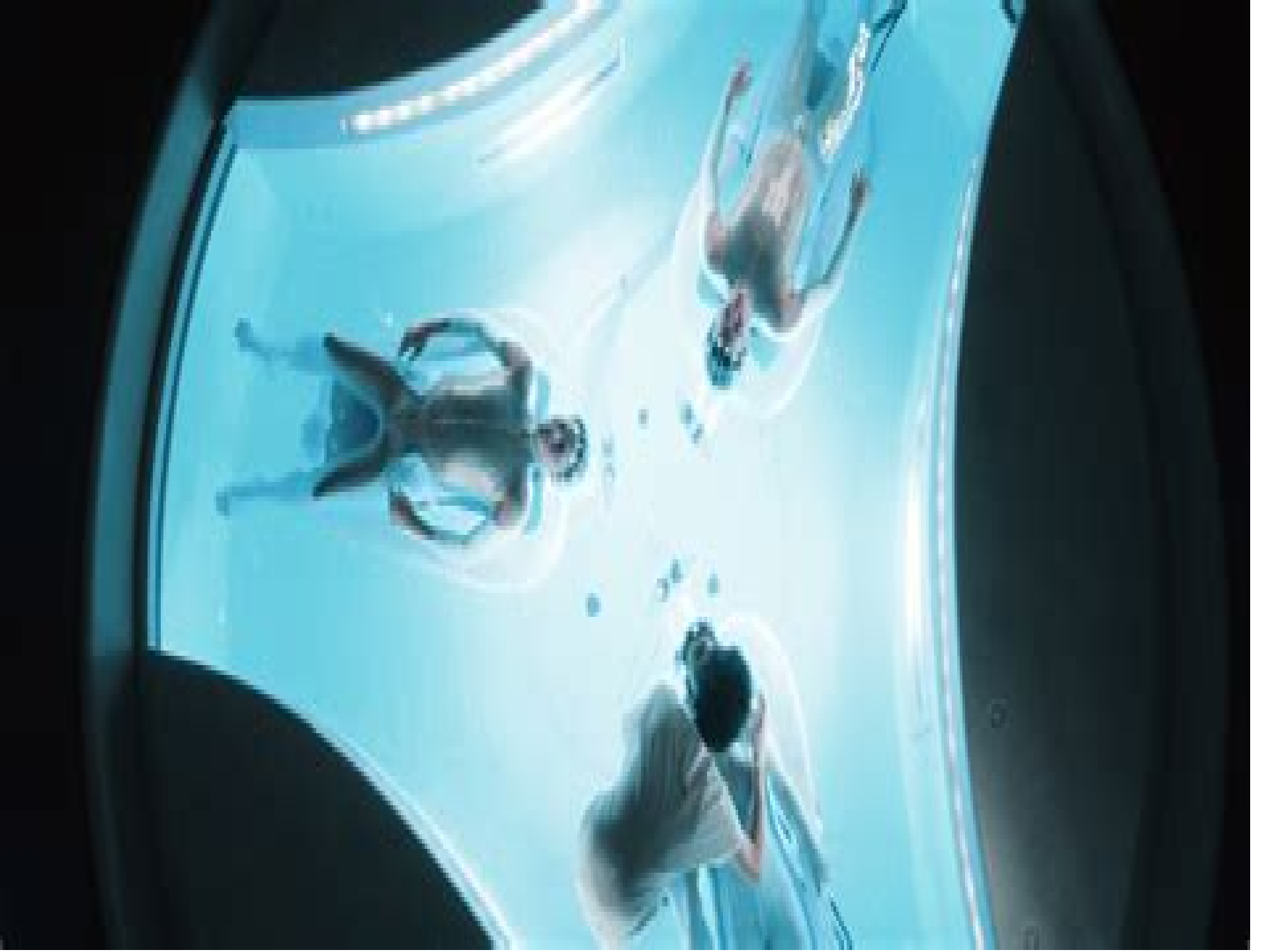

Dick's *The Minority Report* precogs who are imaginary individuals capable of seeing the future are relied upon to stop crime with a consensus report synthesized from two of three precogs. When the protagonist is indicted for a future murder he suspects a conspiracy and seeks out the minority report detailing the suppressed testimony of the third precog. Science works a lot like this science fiction story. Contrary to the view that scientists in a field all share the same paradigm as Thomas Kuhn famously argued, scientists support different and competing research programs. Statements of scientific consensus need to be actively synthesized from the work of different scientists. Not all scientific work will be equally credited by science as a whole. While this system works well enough for most purposes, it is possible for minority views to fail to get the hearing that they deserve. This book analyzes the support that should be given to minority views, reconsidering classic debates in science and technology studies and examining numerous case studies.

Theorizing Surveillance David Lyon, 2006-08-01 This book is about explaining surveillance processes and practices in contemporary society. Surveillance studies is a relatively new multi-disciplinary enterprise that aims to understand who watches who, how the watched participate in and sometimes question their surveillance, why surveillance occurs and with what effects. This book brings together some of the world's leading surveillance scholars to discuss the why question. The field has been dominated since the groundbreaking work of Michel Foucault by the idea of the panopticon, and this book explores why this metaphor has been central in discussions of surveillance, what is fruitful in the panoptic approach and what are the possible approaches that can throw better light on the phenomena in question. Since the advent of networked computer databases and especially since 9/11, questions of surveillance have come increasingly to the forefront of democratic political and policy debates in the global north and to an extent in the global South. Civil liberties, democratic participation and privacy are some of the issues that are raised by these developments. But little progress can be made in responding to these issues without an adequate understanding of how, how well and whether or not surveillance works. This book explores the theoretical questions in a way that is grounded in and attuned to empirical realities.

The Parallax View Slavoj Žižek, 2009-02-13 In his long-awaited magnum opus, he theorizes the parallax gap in the ontological, the scientific and the political and rehabilitates dialectical materialism. *The Parallax View* is Slavoj Žižek's most substantial theoretical work to appear in many years. Žižek himself describes it as his magnum opus. Parallax can be defined as the apparent displacement of an object caused by a change in observational position. Žižek is interested in the parallax gap separating two points between which no synthesis or mediation is possible, linked by an impossible short circuit of levels that can never meet. From this consideration of parallax, Žižek begins a rehabilitation of dialectical materialism. Modes of parallax can be seen in different domains of today's theory, from the wave

particle duality in quantum physics to the parallax of the unconscious in Freudian psychoanalysis between interpretations of the formation of the unconscious and theories of drives In *The Parallax View* i ek with his usual astonishing erudition focuses on three main modes of parallax the ontological difference the ultimate parallax that conditions our very access to reality the scientific parallax the irreducible gap between the phenomenal experience of reality and its scientific explanation which reaches its apogee in today s brain sciences according to which nobody is home in the skull just stacks of brain meat a condition i ek calls the unbearable lightness of being no one and the political parallax the social antagonism that allows for no common ground Between his discussions of these three modes i ek offers interludes that deal with more specific topics including an ethical act in a novel by Henry James and anti anti-Semitism *The Parallax View* not only expands i ek s Lacanian Hegelian approach to new domains notably cognitive brain sciences but also provides the systematic exposition of the conceptual framework that underlies his entire work Philosophical and theological analysis detailed readings of literature cinema and music coexist with lively anecdotes and obscene jokes
