What is problemoriented policing?

- Crime incidents may only be symptoms
 - To extinguish need to deal with the "real", underlying problems
- This is supposedly different from "community-oriented policing"
 - Acceptance that traditional crime-fighting methods may be ineffective
 - BUT -- no value judgments as to police role (fact-based rather than ideological)
 - To respond to problems police must be flexible and willing to experiment
 - Emphasis on crime prevention, not responding "after the fact"
- Like in community policing, external relationships are important
 - Collaborate with other agencies, politicians, community groups, private service providers, local businesses
- Environmental design important ("target hardening")
- Not necessarily a "kinder and gentler" approach
 - May call for more intrusion, not less
