- Service Cloud:** Service Cloud also provides functionalities such as entitlements, knowledge bases and case management. Used by support organizations.

- Standard Objects:** The objects are already created for the user by the Salesforce platform. Also called Account Object.

Standard Objects are: Account, Account History, Case, Contact, User, Asset, Domain.

- Custom Objects:** Objects that are created by user, based on the business processes.

Features:

- Can build page layouts to control fields, also the read-write access.
- Can import custom object records.

- External Objects:** The objects which you create map to the data stored outside your organization.

- Can create reports and dashboards to analyze custom object data.
- Can create a custom tab for the custom object.
- Can track fields and events.
- Can import custom object records.

- Standard Objects:** The objects are already created for the user by the Salesforce platform. Also called Account Object.

Standard Objects are: Account, Account History, Case, Contact, User, Asset, Domain.

- Custom Objects:** Objects that are created by user, based on the business processes.

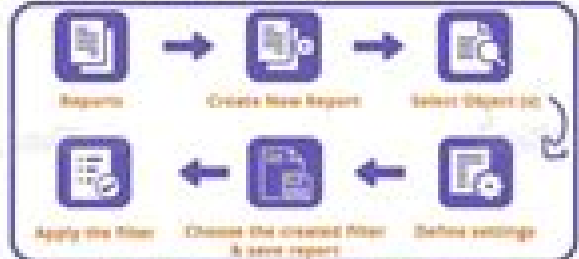

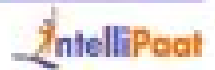
