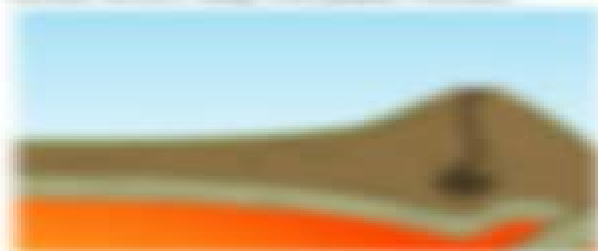
Question: What happens when two tectonic plates meet?

- Collision** - Boundaries where two plates move towards each other. When the two plates meet, they can move together or apart. If they move together, it is called a **collision**. When they move apart, it is called a **divergence**.

How would you describe the motion of plates in a collision zone?

The plates are moving together and creating the land to rise up - this is called a mountain range.
