



guides the story. They build the setting and populate it with a cast of supporting characters. The Storyteller describes what happens in the world as a result of what the players say and do. It is the Storyteller who advances the rules and brings fascinating new challenges into the game.

The Storyteller's primary duty is to make sure the other players have a good time. They do that by telling a good story. Unlike novellas or film dramas, however, they don't simply tell the story from back to front. Storytellers create the setting and set the plot in motion — having a “player-shaped hole” for the other participants to make their own decisions in the roles of the primary characters, defining the story concerns and setting as they go. Storytellers maintain a careful balance between narration and adjudication, between narration and conflict, between story and game, between planning and improvisation. Sometimes Storytellers act the parts or even describe the action, but mostly they decide what occurs in reaction to the words and actions of the characters, as fairly and impartially as they can. Storytellers are an audience, not critics.

THE PLAYERS

Although the Storyteller plays the game and makes pre-made choices in hundreds of situations, the same player often is those participants in the table who assume the roles of the central characters in the story. As a player in *World of Darkness*, you create one main character and then roleplay them. You speak for them, you input them to actions, you decide what they desire in the world of the game and how they want to attain or accomplish it. The Storyteller relates the story to those desires, the players build characters who have a role in that story, and whose actions complete or thwarted it.

Often when you describe the actions you want to take the Storyteller may ask you to make a dice roll to see if you succeed in doing what you have described. Your character's Traits — descriptions of their strengths and weaknesses — describe how well your character can do certain things. Knowing your character's abilities, both natural and supernatural, gives you the tools to choose from in deciding that character the best chance of success. As a storyteller, your character is definitely good at high-grade violence, but violence may rarely prove to be the best solution to the problems they face. That's important. As a player, you're not trying to “win,” you're usually through your character may well be...) Instead, you're working with the other players and the Storyteller to tell an engaging story. Success is great, but failure isn't

an embarrassment, which usually makes more story to tell.

Then, a good player balances acting and strategy, considering their character's personality and motives alongside their Traits and supernatural actions. You employ your character's strengths and work around their weaknesses to achieve your goals, even in the world outside battle and danger. Your character's actions help shape the world as a player, you can do all other and determine the story. The Storyteller incorporates them for drama and to inform the most dramatic, engaging, and challenging narrative possible.

As with all *World of Darkness* games, the potential for intensity and intimacy in *World of Darkness* plays lives in their own characters, and in the drama and fiction of their fellow players' characters. Much of the game's impact and theme is how other players must compare for the Storyteller's last one another's situation. Jonathan Swift's Word-Book A. C. Elias,John Fischer,Panthea Reid,2017-06-01 This Word Book is presumably the only work of Jonathan Swift s not in print until now Since the 1690s Swift had been formulating a list of words and definitions for

his protégé Esther Johnson beginning with terms from the Book of Common Prayer. His was apparently an ongoing list kept rather haphazardly with open spaces for adding new words. About 1710 when Swift was in London, Johnson in Dublin set out to formalize the dictionary by copying out Swift's words and definitions to make an orderly and careful book with no blank spaces. Probably in 1713 when Swift returned to Ireland, Johnson presented her Word Book to him, but his schoolmasterly corrections of her work may have offended her. After Johnson's death in 1728, Swift gave the Word Book to their mutual friend Elizabeth Sican. It was passed down over generations until in 1976 the young American Swiftian A. C. Elias Jr. bought it, intending to edit it in his old age. Before his early death in 2008, Elias asked John Fischer to assume the challenge of bringing the book into print. Fischer took on the task until 2015 when he too passed away, after which his wife Panthea Reid completed the task.
