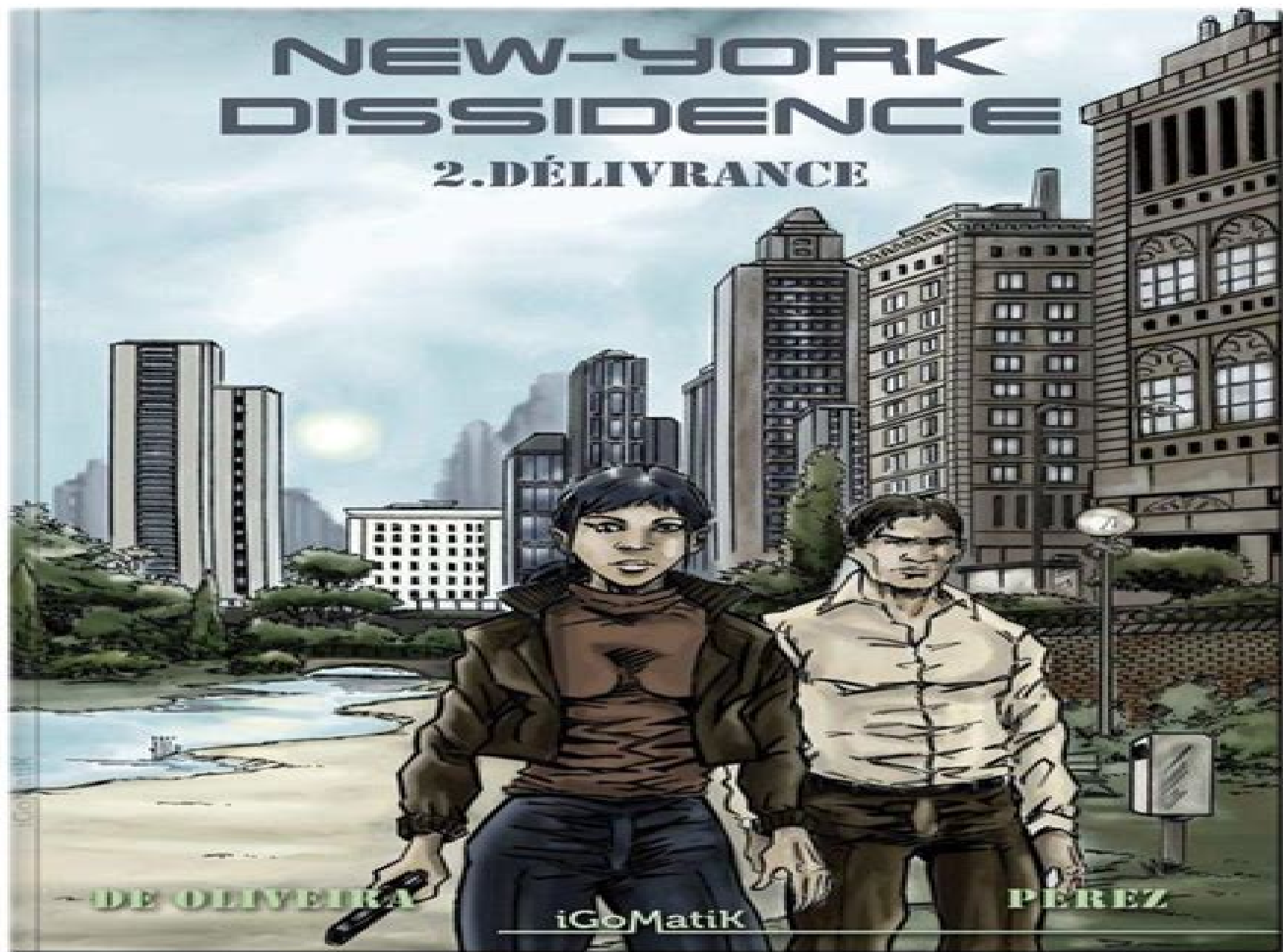

Dissidence Marie Leduc, 2018-11-20 How the valorization of artistic and political dissidence has contributed to the rise of Chinese contemporary art in the West Interest in Chinese contemporary art increased dramatically in the West shortly after the 1989 Tiananmen Square protests Sparked by political sympathy and the mediatized response to the event Western curators critics and art historians were quick to view the new art as an expression of dissident resistance to the Chinese regime In this book Marie Leduc proposes that this attribution of political dissidence is not only the result of latent Cold War perceptions about China but also indicative of the art world's demand for artistically and politically provocative work a demand that mirrors the valorization of free expression in liberal democracies Focusing on nine Chinese artists Wang Du Wang Keping Huang Yong Ping Yang Jiechang Chen Zhen Yan Pei Ming Shen Yuan Ru Xiaofan and Du Zhenjun who migrated to Paris in and around 1989 Leduc explores how their work was recognized before and after the Tiananmen Square incident Drawing on personal interviews with the artists and curators and through an analysis of important exhibitions events reviews and curatorial texts she demonstrates how these and other Chinese artists have been celebrated both for their artistic dissidence their formal innovations and introduction of new media and concepts and for their political dissidence how their work challenges political values in both China and the West As Leduc concludes the rise of Chinese contemporary art in the West highlights the significance of artistic and political dissidence in the production of contemporary art and the often unrecognized relationship between contemporary art and liberal democracy

Confronting Totalitarian Minds: Jan Patočka on Politics and Dissidence Aspen E. Brinton, 2021-05-01 The Czech philosopher Jan Patočka not only witnessed some of the most turbulent politics of twentieth century Central Europe but shaped his philosophy in response to that tumult One of the last students of Edmund Husserl and Martin Heidegger he inspired Václav Havel and other dissidents who confronted the Communist regime before 1989 as well as being actively involved in authoring and enacting Charter 77 He died in 1977 from medical complications resulting from interrogations of the secret police *Confronting Totalitarian Minds* examines his legacy along with several contemporary applications of his ideas about dissidence solidarity and the human being's existential confrontation with unjust politics Expanding the current possibilities of comparative political theory the author puts Patočka's ideas about dissidence citizen mobilization and civic responsibility into conversation with notable world historical figures like Mahatma Gandhi Vaclav Havel Dietrich Bonhoeffer and other contemporary activists In adding a fresh voice to contemporary conversations on transcending injustice *Confronting Totalitarian Minds* seeks to educate a wider audience about this philosopher's continued relevance to political dissidents across the world

Architecture and the Paradox of Dissidence Ines Weizman, 2014-02-03 *Architecture and the Paradox of Dissidence* maps out and expands upon the methodologies of architectural action and reinvigorates the concept of dissent within the architectural field It expands the notion of dissidence to other similar practices and strategies of resistance in a variety of historical and geographical contexts

The book also discusses how the gestures and techniques of past struggles as well as dilemmas of working in politically suppressive regimes can help to inform those of today This collection of essays from expert scholars demonstrates the multiple responses to this subject the potential and dangers of dissidence and thus constructs a robust lexicon of concepts that will point to possible ways forward for politically and theoretically committed architects and practitioners

Dissident Marxism David Renton, 2013-07-04 We are witnessing the birth of a new politics anti capitalist libertarian and anti war But where do today s dissidents come from Dissident Marxism argues that their roots can be found in the life and work of an earlier generation of socialist revolutionaries including such inspiring figures as the Soviet poet Mayakovsky the Marxist philosopher Karl Korsch Communist historians Edward Thompson and Dona Torr the Egyptian surrealist Georges Henein American New Left economists Paul Baran and Paul Sweezy advocates of Third World liberation including Walter Rodney and Samir Amin Harry Braverman the author of Labor and Monopoly Capital and David Widgery the journalist of the May 68 revolts What these writers shared was a commitment to the values of socialism from below the idea that change must be driven by the mass movements of the oppressed In a world dominated by slump fascism and war they retained a commitment to total democracy Dissident Marxism describes the left in history Some readers will enjoy it as a history of revolutionary socialism in the years between Stalin s rise and the fall of the Berlin Wall Others will find here a challenging thesis that the most enduring of left wing traditions and highly relevant to the times we live in today were located in a space between the New Left and Trotskyism Dissident Marxism explores the lives and thinking of some of the most creative and striking members of the twentieth century left and asks if the new anti capitalist movement might provide an opportunity for just such another left wing generation to emerge

The Dissident Politics in Václav Havel's Vanek Plays Carol Strong, 2023-09-05 The Dissident Politics in Václav Havel's Vanek Plays Who Is Ferdinand Vanek Anyway focuses on Ferdinand Vanek a semi autobiographical character created by Václav Havel and featured in a series of nine plays written by Havel himself and three other dissident writers Pavel Kohout Pavel Landovsk and Jir Dienstbier By exploring the Vanek experience Carol Strong details a multi episodic absurdist journey that provides an insider s view of the challenges facing those daring enough to question the status quo a view that remains relevant today Strong s contention is that the lines found in these plays served as a secret language of dissent in Cold War Czechoslovakia which called the citizenry to contemplate the need for societal reform As the plays were written at a time when the work of Havel and other dissidents were banned the plays were never performed publicly but through clandestine living room performances and the sharing of samizdat scripts the plays found an audience Select phrases were indeed whispered throughout underground networks and helped forge a sense of oppositional solidarity among potential activists Strong s argument is that the Vanek experience metaphorically highlights how official power mechanisms are among the least insidious forms of societal power as the state must follow predictable patterns of legal jurisprudence By contrast non governmental forms of power as exercised by one s

fellow citizens through informal social channels can challenge oppositional actors more because of the personal tone they adopt Using this approach Strong presents a timelessly relevant critique of modern society with its consumerist conformist tendencies

Dissident Practices Claudia Calirman,2023-03-01 In *Dissident Practices* Claudia Calirman examines sixty years of visual art by prominent and emerging Brazilian women artists from the 1960s to the present covering the period from the military dictatorship to the return to democracy in the mid 1980s the social changes of the 2000s the rise of the Right in the late 2010s and the recent development of an overtly feminist art practice Though they were lauded as key figures in Brazilian art these artists still faced adversity and constraints because of their gender Although many of them in the 1960s and 1970s disavowed the term feminism Calirman gives a nuanced account of how they responded to authoritarianism engaged with trauma in the aftermath of the military dictatorship interrogated social gender norms and fought against women's objectification By battling social inequalities structures of power and state violence these artists create political agency in a society in which women remain targets of brutality and discrimination

Dissident Philosophers T. Allan Hillman,Tully Borland,2021-11-19 The book consists of sixteen essays and an introduction from prominent philosophers who are at odds with the predominant political trends of academic philosophy political trends primarily associated with leftism Some of these philosophers identify explicitly with the political right an admittedly broad term which ranges from American conservative to British Tory from religious right to non religious right from libertarian to authoritarian Yet other dissident philosophers eschew the left right dichotomy altogether while maintaining a firm political distance from the majority of their left leaning colleagues The primary goal of the volume is to represent a broad constituency of political philosophies and perspectives at variance with the prevailing political sentiments of the academy Each essay is partly autobiographical in nature detailing personal experiences that have influenced these philosophers throughout their lives and partly philosophical putting forth reflections on the intellectual viability of a right leaning or decidedly non left leaning political philosophy or some segment of it The contemporary university is supposed to be the locus of viewpoint diversity and yet as is evident to professors students and virtually anyone else who sets foot within its halls it most certainly is not particularly in matters political Nevertheless these essays are not instances of special pleading or grievance incitement Instead each article provides a glimpse into the life of an academic philosopher whose views have largely been at odds with peers and colleagues Furthermore all of the essays were consciously constructed with the aim of being philosophically rigorous while eschewing technical language and verbose prose In short the essays will be enjoyable to a wide audience

Dissident Legacies of Samizdat Social Media Activism Piotr Wciślik, 2021-07-22 This book tells the story of the dissident imaginary of samizdat activists the political culture they created and the pivotal role that culture had in sustaining the resilience of the oppositional movement in Poland between 1976 and 1990 This unlicensed print culture has been seen as one of the most emblematic social worlds of dissent Since the Cold War the audacity of harnessing obsolete print technology known as samizdat to break the modern monopoly of information of the party state has fascinated many yet this book looks beyond the Cold War frame to reappraise its historical novelty and significance What made that culture resilient and rewarding this book argues was the correspondence between certain set of ideas and media practices namely the form of samizdat social media which both embodied and projected the prefigurative philosophy of political action asserting that small forms of collective agency can have a transformative effect on public life here and now and are uniquely capable of achieving a democratic new beginning This prefigurative vision of the transition from communism had a fundamental impact on the broader oppositional movement Yet while both the rise of Solidarity and the breakthrough of 1989 seemed to do justice to that vision both pivotal moments found samizdat social media activists making history that was not to their liking Back in the day their estrangement was overshadowed by the main axis of

contention between the society and the state Foregrounding the internal controversies they protagonized this book adds nuance to our understanding of the broader legacy of dissent and its relevance for the networked protests of today

Dissident Histories in the Soviet Union Barbara Martin, 2019-05-16 How was it possible to write history in the Soviet Union under strict state control and without access to archives What methods of research did these historians be they academic that is based at formal institutions or independent rely on And how was their work influenced by their complex and shifting relationships with the state To answer these questions Barbara Martin here tracks the careers of four bold and important dissidents Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn Roy Medvedev Aleksandr Nekrich and Anton Antonov Ovseenko Based on extensive archival research and interviews with some of the authors themselves as well as those close to them the result is a nuanced and very necessary history of Soviet dissident history writing from the relative liberalisation of de Stalinisation through increasing repression and persecution in the Brezhnev era to liberalisation once more during perestroika In the process Martin sheds light onto late Soviet society and its relationship with the state as well as the ways in which this dissidence participated in weakening the Soviet regime during Perestroika This is important reading for all scholars working on late Soviet history and society

Dissident Writings of Arab Women Brinda J. Catherine Lambert, 2024-11-12 Dissident Women Beguines and the Quest for Spiritual Authority focuses on the responses of a group of twenty first century women to the lives and writings of thirteenth century beguine mystics and reveals how the struggle to discover their own inner spiritual authority connects two groups of women across centuries For contemporary women who are disenchanted with the institutional church and who seek spiritual direction models deeply rooted within the tradition may not be the most helpful The author explores the value of exemplars from the fringes ushering Hadewijch of Brabant Mechthild of Magdeburg and Marguerite Porete into the spotlight The contemporary women studied developed a

relationship with the beguines that transformed and influenced their own journeys Their encounters underline the importance of remembering the beguine mystics the value of contemplative engagement with historical mystics and the need for explicit validation of the richness of the edges of tradition within spiritual direction Dissident Women Beguines and the Quest for Spiritual Authority will be of particular interest to scholars of mysticism and spirituality as well as practical pastoral and feminist theology

Freedom's Ordeal Peter Juviler, 2010-11-24 Fifteen countries have emerged from the collapse of the Soviet Union *Freedom's Ordeal* recounts the struggles of these newly independent nations to achieve freedom and to establish support for fundamental human rights Although history has shown that states emerging from collapsed empires rarely achieve full democracy in their first try Peter Juviler analyzes these successor states as crucial and not always unpromising tests of democracy's viability in postcommunist countries Taking into account the particularly difficult legacies of Soviet communism *Freedom's Ordeal* is distinguished by its careful tracing of the historical background with special attention to human rights before during and after communism Juviler suggests that the culture and practices of despotism may wither wherever modernization conflicts with tyranny and with the curtailment or denial of democratic rights and freedoms

A Ransomed Dissident Igor Golomstock, 2018-10-25 In 1939 a ten year old Igor Golomstock accompanied his mother a medical doctor to the vast network of labour camps in the Russian Far East While she tended patients he was minded by assorted trusty prisoners hardened criminals and returned to Moscow an almost feral adolescent fluent in obscene prison jargon but intellectually ignorant Despite this dubious start he became a leading art historian and co author with his close friend Andrey Sinyavsky of the first deeply controversial monograph on Picasso published in the Soviet Union His writings on his 43 years in the Soviet Union offer a rare insight into life as a quietly subversive art historian and the post Stalin dissident community In vivid prose Golomstock shows the difficulties of publishing curating and talking about Western art in Soviet Russia and with self

deprecating humour the absurd tragicomedy of life for the Moscow intelligentsia during Khrushchev's thaw and Brezhnev's stagnation. He also offers a unique personal perspective on the 1966 trial of Sinyavsky and Yuri Daniel, widely considered the end of Khrushchev's liberalism and the spark that ignited the Soviet dissident movement. In 1972 he was given permission to leave the Soviet Union but only after paying a ransom of more than 25 years' salary, nominally intended to reimburse the state for his education. A remarkable collection of artists, scholars and intellectuals in Russia and the West, including Roland Penrose, came together to help him pay this astronomical sum. His memoirs of life in the UK offer an insider's view of the BBC Russian Service and a penetrating analysis of the notorious feud between Sinyavsky and Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn. Nominated for the Russian Booker Prize on its publication in Russian in 2014, *The Ransomed Dissident* opens a window onto the life of a remarkable man, a dissident of uncompromising moral integrity and with an outstanding gift for friendship.
