NAEP[®] is the only large-scale assessment of student achievement in mathematics and science in the United States. The National Center for Assessment Programs (NCAP)[®] is designed to assess the knowledge, skills and abilities that are critical for college and workforce entry as well as to provide ongoing career self-assessment support. The department is based upon two components: *Measuring the Quality of Student Achievement* and *Measuring the Quality of Student Achievement*.
