1ST PERSON WRITING

- First person point of view is a point of view in which an "I" or "we" serves as the narrator of a piece of fiction. The narrator may be a minor character, observing the action, as the character. In addition, a first-person narrator may be reliable or unreliable.
- First person is often used for describing personal experiences, feelings or stories.
- Writing an effective first-person essay enables you to insert yourself into the essay and can be practice for college admission essays and cover letters that often require the use of the first-person format.
- While first person point of view can allow a reader to feel very close to a specific character's point of view, it also limits the reader to that one perspective. The reader can only know what this character knows. Some writers, especially beginning writers, have a tendency to get stuck in first person point of view.
