#### Introduction:

"Human development can be defined as a process of progressive changes in people's lives over time that enables them to adjust more effectively to their environments." (Drewery & Claiborne, 2014). There are many theories of how children develop, for example, Charles Darwin who proposed that species develop over time, or Piaget who believes "errors are windows to the mind." (Peters, 2018) Each theorist to their own, they link their ideology to make sense of events. (Drewery & Claiborne, 2014). In this report I will be focusing on Mason Durie and Urie Bronfenbrenner, who both create a construction of factors they believe impact the child's development. Durie, takes a holistic approach and focuses on Hauora the wellbeing of the child, whereas Bronfenbrenner's Ecological System Theory shows how the child interacts with five social systems. The ABC's of human development are shown throughout both of these two theories. Affective, Biological, and Cognitive development are demonstrated through a child's emotions, social life, culture, spirituality, morals, genetics, biological make-up, knowledge, thinking, and understanding, (Paki, 2018).

#### Links to Maori theory:

Mason Durie has a holistic approach to a child's development, meaning that he focuses on the more spiritual aspects of impact. The Wairua and Hauora/Wellbeing of a child has a great influence on their development, which is portrayed through the four walls of the Whare Tapa Wha. The taha tinana being the physical wellbeing; taha hinengaro, the mental and emotional wellbeing; taha whanau being family and social wellbeing; taha wairua, the spiritual wellbeing; and whenua, being the land/roots that holds everything together. They stimulate eachother through social agreement as "each aspect reflects the person's need to grow competent, nurtured, and sustained in mind, body and soul." (Drewery & Claiborne, 2014). Community involvement, for example, is an essential part of the Whare Tapa Wha as it is one of the four walls that hold the Whare together. Students need support from home as well as school staff/teachers, for their wellbeing in development. The Montessori method of children's development suggests that for a child to learn effectively, the need of a learning triangle of collaboration between student, parent, and teacher is vital.
