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A Colonial Woman's Bookshelf Kevin J. Hayes,2016-02-05 A Colonial Woman s Bookshelf represents a significant contribution to the study of the intellectual life of women in British North America Kevin J Hayes studies the books these women read and the reasons why they read them As Hayes notes recent studies on the literary tastes of early American women have concentrated on the post revolutionary period when several women novelists emerged Yet he observes women were reading long before they began writing and publishing novels and in fact mounting evidence now suggests that literacy rates among colonial women were much higher than previously supposed To reconstruct what might have filled a typical colonial woman s bookshelf Hayes has mined such sources as wills and estate inventories surviving volumes inscribed by women public and private library catalogs sales ledgers borrowing records from subscription libraries and contemporary biographical sketches of notable colonial women Hayes identifies several categories of reading material These range from devotional works and conduct books to midwifery guides and cookery books from novels and travel books to science books In his concluding chapter he describes the tensions that were developing near the end of the colonial period between the emerging cult of domesticity and the appetite for learning many women displayed With its meticulous research and rich detail A Colonial Woman s Bookshelf makes a valuable contribution to our understanding of the complexities of life in seventeenth and eighteenth century America

Mandeville William Godwin,2015-12-01 William Godwin s Mandeville was described as his best novel by Percy Shelley who sent a copy to Lord Byron and it was immediately recognized by its other admirers as a work of unique power Written

one year after the battle of Waterloo and set in an earlier revolutionary period between the execution of Charles I and the Restoration Mandeville is a novel of psychological warfare The narrative begins with Mandeville's rescue from the traumatic aftermath of the Ulster Rebellion of 1641 and proceeds through his early education by a fanatical Presbyterian minister to his persecution at Winchester school his constant and not unjustified paranoia and his confinement in an asylum Mandeville's final desperate attempt to prevent his sister's marriage to his enemy ends with his disfigurement which also defaces endings based on settlement or reconciliation The novel's events have many resonances with Godwin's own period The historical appendices offer contemporary reviews including Shelley's letter to Godwin praising Mandeville material explaining the novel's complex historical background and contemporary writings on war madness and trauma **The Portrait and the Book**

Megan Walsh, 2017-05-15 In the nineteenth century new image making methods like steel engraving and lithography caused a surge in the publication of illustrated books in the United States Yet even before the widespread use of these technologies Americans had already established the illustrated book format as central to the nation's literary culture In *The Portrait and the Book* Megan Walsh argues that colonial era author portraits such as Benjamin Franklin's and Phillis Wheatley's frontispieces political portraits that circulated during the debates over the Constitution such as those of the Founders by Charles Willson Peale and portraits of beloved fictional characters in the 1790s such as those of Samuel Richardson's heroine Pamela shaped readers' conceptions of American literature Illustrations played a key role in American literary culture despite the fact there was little demand for books by American writers Indeed most of the illustrated books bought sold and shared by Americans were either imported British works or reprinted versions of those imported editions As a result in addition to embellishing books illustrations provided readers with crucial information about the country's status as a former colony Through an examination of readers' portrait collecting habits writers' employment of ekphrasis printers' efforts to secure American made illustrations for periodicals and engravers' reproductions of British book illustrations Walsh uncovers in late eighteenth century America a dynamic but forgotten visual culture that was inextricably tied to the printing industry and to the early US literary imagination **Mark's Argumentative Jesus**

Making Love Paul Kelleher, 2015-07-16 In *Making Love Sentiment and Sexuality in Eighteenth Century British Literature* Paul Kelleher revises the history of sexuality from the vantage point of the literary history of sentimentalism Kelleher demonstrates how eighteenth century British philosophers essayists and novelists fundamentally reconceived the relations among sentiment sexuality and moral virtue It is his contention that sentimental discourse both philosophical and literary posited heterosexual desire as the precondition of moral feeling and conduct The author further suggests that sentimental writers fashioned the ideal of conjugal love as an ideological antidote to the theories of self love and self interest found in the works of Thomas Hobbes and Bernard Mandeville Heterosexual desire and its culmination in conjugal love in other words were represented as the privileged means for an individual to transcend self love and to develop a moral sensibility attuned to the thoughts and feelings of others At the same time Kelleher suggests other pleasures and desires particularly those rooted in same sex eroticism were increasingly depicted as antithetical to conjugal love and thus were morally devalued and socially disenfranchised Kelleher's argument unfolds through close readings of a variety of texts including Shaftesbury's *Characteristics of Men Manners Opinions* *Times* Joseph Addison and Richard Steele's *The Tatler* and *The Spectator* Eliza Haywood's *Love in Excess* Samuel Richardson's *Pamela* and Henry Fielding's *Tom Jones* Although these texts embody diverse rhetorical strategies and thematic concerns he shows how they collectively reinforce an overarching sentimental ideology on the one hand heterosexual desire and conjugal love become synonymous with sympathy benevolence and moral goodness while on the other hand same sex desire is pathologized as a selfish withdrawal from procreation domesticity sociability and ultimately humanity itself
