Module 6.1 Remembering Memory Processes: Human Memory as an Information Processing System

- --Our memory can be conceptualized as an information processing system split into 3 categories:
 - Encoding: Coverting information into a form usable in memory
 - Relies on different sensory modalities, ie: auditory or visual.
- Sometimes people rely on meaning of incoming information, called semantics

ie: might remember key terms better if you try to understand what it means rather than memorizing verbatim

- Storage: Retaining information in memory
 -How long something is kept depends on system being used
 - Retrieval: Bringing to mind information in memory
 Where you're accessing conscious information
 Some memories easier to recall than others, but
 might be dependent on retrieval cues, which are

cues associated with original learning that may facilitate retrieval of these memories

Sensory Memory

- Known as briefest storage system that hold memories of sensory impressions for short period of time ie: sights and sounds
- -Memory here lasts from fraction of second to 3-4 seconds
- Considered to be first memory system where info passes through our system into memory storage system

Iconic Memory: where mental representations of an image is held for a fraction of a second

Idetic Memory: AKA photographic memory, where people can look at something quickly and recall this information
