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web acid alkali salt water we say that the acid and alkali are the reactants and the salt and water are the products of a neutralisation reaction

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web 1 sodium hydroxide solution is poured into a beaker of hydrochloric acid which contains a thermometer showing room temperature 2 the beaker now contains sodium chloride and water and the

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web reacting two solutions eg acid and alkali place the polystyrene cup inside the glass beaker to make it more stable

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produce salts neutralisation is the reaction between an acid and a base

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web sep 20 2014 i will illustrate this with some examples when an acid is neutralised by an alkali the reaction is exothermic
eg 1. $\text{HCl(aq)} + \text{NaOH(aq)} \rightarrow \text{NaCl(aq)} + \text{H}_2\text{O(l)}$ for which $\Delta H = -57 \text{ kJ mol}^{-1}$ eg 2. $\text{HNO}_3(\text{aq}) + \text{KOH(aq)} \rightarrow \text{KNO}_3(\text{aq}) + \text{H}_2\text{O(l)}$ for which $\Delta H = -57 \text{ kJ mol}^{-1}$

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web the enthalpy change of neutralisation is defined as the enthalpy change when solutions of an acid and alkali react
together to produce one mole of water for example $\text{HCl(aq)} + \text{NaOH(aq)} \rightarrow \text{NaCl(aq)} + \text{H}_2\text{O(l)}$ you can see that one mole of water is
produced when one mole of HCl or one mole of NaOH reacts
