Albany Plan of Union ----- Correct Answer ----- -a plan to create a unified government for all 13 colonies
-suggested by Benjamin Franklin
-the colonies did not like this plan

Fundamental Orders of Connecticut ----- Correct Answer ----- -document which describes the set up of the government
-including setting, structure and powers
-FIRST WRITTEN CONSTITUTION

John Peter Zenger Trial? Why was it important? ----- Correct Answer ----- -Zenger published the "New York Weekly Journal" which harshly pointed out corruption in the government, it accused the governor of crimes etc.
-the government was obviously mad but he had a right
- this led to freedom of the press

Describe the French and Indian War.
(Who, when, why and the effects) ----- Correct Answer ----- -fought between Britain and France
-France was expanding into the Ohio River Valley this caused conflicts with the British because they wanted the land
-the war ended with the Treaty of Paris
-Although Britain had huge territorial gains they were left in HUGE debt

Townshend Act ----- Correct Answer ----- -designed to collect revenue from colonists
-put duties (taxes) on popular products

Boston Massacre ----- Correct Answer ----- -officials were in Boston to enforce tax laws
-the colonists were mad about the taxes and this built great tension
-the British regulars ended up killing 5 people

First Continental Congress ----- Correct Answer ----- -composed of delegates from each colony
-they met to discuss the cohesive acts (Britain's reaction to the colonies resistance on taxes)

Second Continental Congress ----- Correct Answer ----- -declared the American Revolution had BEGUN
