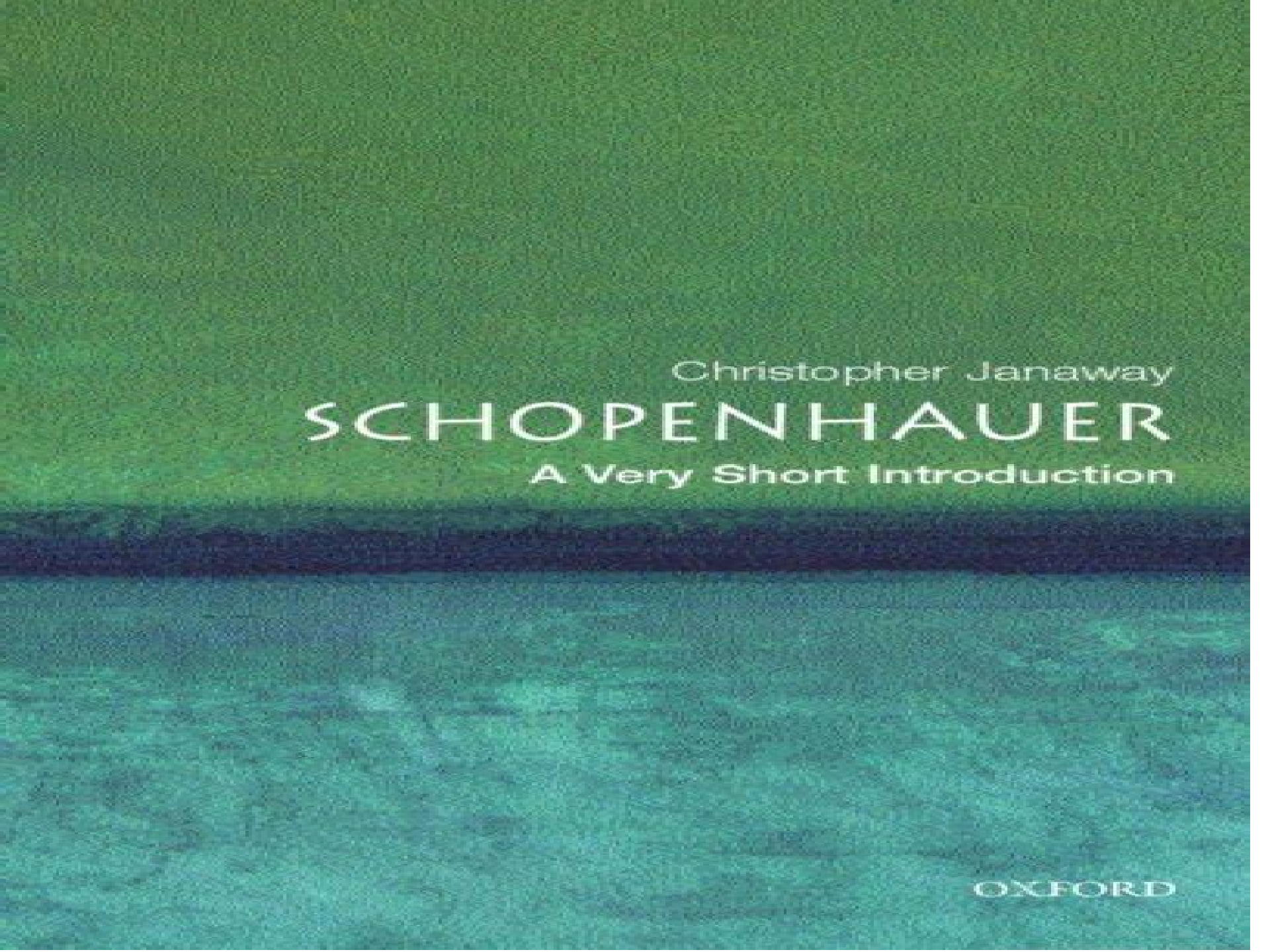

Prior to that decision, he had been studying medicine at the university in Göttingen. By that age, however, he had concluded that life was a troublesome affair. So he resolved to spend his life reflecting upon it. Schopenhauer was doggedly determined to persevere in what he considered his mission in life: to reflect on the ever-disquieting puzzle of existence, to ascertain the meaning of living in a world steeped in suffering and death.
