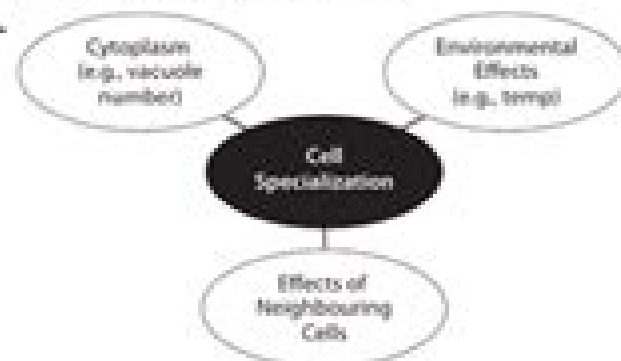
9. Sweating is an example of osmosis. The gas exchange in our lungs is an example of diffusion.
