Thomaz, 2022-06-01 Learning from Demonstration LfD explores techniques for learning a task policy from examples provided by a human teacher The field of LfD has grown into an extensive body of literature over the past 30 years with a wide variety of approaches for encoding human demonstrations and modeling skills and tasks Additionally we have recently seen a focus on gathering data from non expert human teachers i e domain experts but not robotics experts In this book we provide an introduction to the field with a focus on the unique technical challenges associated with designing robots that learn from naive human teachers We begin in the introduction with a unification of the various terminology seen in the literature as well as an outline of the design choices one has in designing an LfD system Chapter 2 gives a brief survey of the psychology literature that provides insights from human social learning that are relevant to designing robotic social learners Chapter 3 walks through an LfD interaction surveying the design choices one makes and state of the art approaches in prior work First is the choice of input how the human teacher interacts with the robot to provide demonstrations Next is the choice of modeling technique Currently there is a dichotomy in the field between approaches that model low level motor skills and those that model high level tasks composed of primitive actions We devote a chapter to each of these Chapter 7 is devoted to interactive and active learning approaches that allow the robot to refine an existing task model And finally Chapter 8 provides best practices for evaluation of LfD systems with a focus on how to approach experiments with human subjects in this domain TRUST IN ROBOTS Sabine T. The use of machine learning for detecting malicious entities creates an incentive among adversaries to evade detection by changing their behavior or the content of malicius objects they develop The field of adversarial machine learning has emerged to study vulnerabilities of machine learning approaches in adversarial settings and to develop techniques to make learning robust to adversarial manipulation This book provides a technical overview of this field After reviewing machine learning concepts and approaches as well as common use cases of these in adversarial settings we present a general categorization of attacks on machine learning We then address two major categories of attacks and associated defenses decision time attacks in which an adversary changes the nature of instances seen by a learned model at the time of prediction in order to cause errors and poisoning or training time attacks in which the actual training dataset is maliciously modified In our final chapter devoted to technical content we discuss recent techniques for attacks on deep learning as well as approaches for improving robustness of deep neural networks We conclude with a discussion of several important issues in the area of adversarial learning that in our view warrant further research Given the increasing interest in the area of adversarial machine learning we hope this book provides readers with the tools necessary to successfully engage in research and practice of machine learning in adversarial settings Positive Unlabeled Learning Kristen Jaskie, Andreas Spanias, 2022-04-20 Machine learning and artificial intelligence AI are powerful tools that create predictive models extract information and help make complex decisions They do this by examining an enormous quantity of labeled training data to find patterns too complex for human observation However in many real world applications well labeled data can be difficult expensive or even impossible to obtain In some cases such as when identifying rare objects like new archeological sites or secret enemy military facilities in satellite images acquiring labels could require months of trained human observers at incredible expense Other times as when attempting to predict disease infection during a pandemic such as COVID 19 reliable true labels may be nearly impossible to
