Each night Sisi Ama Efe and Joyce stand in the windows of Antwerp's red light district promising to make men's desires come true if only for half an hour. Pledged to the fierce Madam and a mysterious pimp named Dele, the girls share an apartment but little else; they keep their heads down knowing that one step out of line could cost them a week's wages. They open their bodies to strangers but their hearts to no one, each focused on earning enough to get herself free to send money home or save up for her own future. Then suddenly a murder shatters the still surface of their lives. Drawn together by tragedy and the loss of one of their own, the women realize that they must choose between their secrets and their safety. As they begin to tell their stories, their confessions reveal the face in Efe's hidden photograph, Ama's lifelong search for a father, Joyce's true name, and Sisi's deepest secrets, and all their tales of fear, displacement, and love concluding in a chance meeting with a handsome, sinister stranger. *On Black Sisters Street* marks the U.S. publication debut of Chika Unigwe, a brilliant new writer and a standout voice among contemporary African authors.
