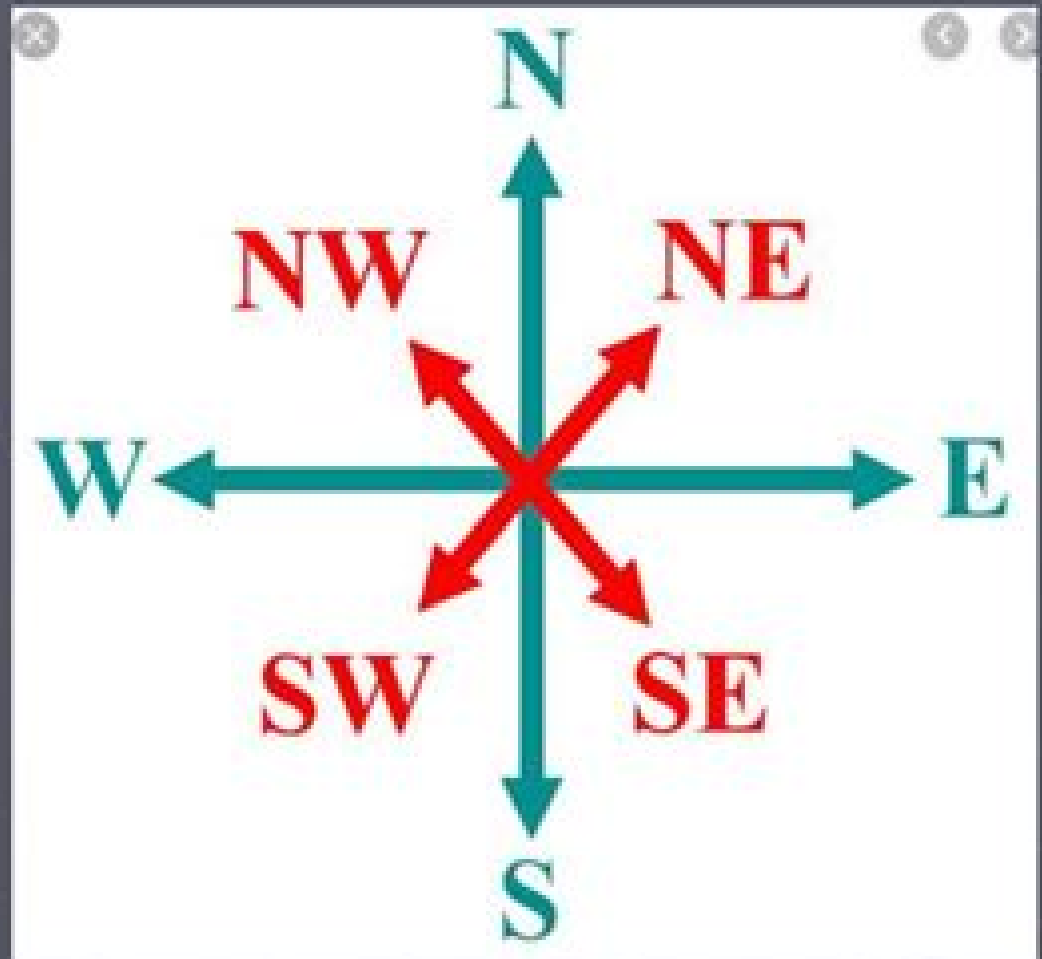

chemical processes growth and development interactions with physiology sensory input reflexes and rhythm control to name just a few have been reported Numerous magnetically induced changes in behavior have also been described Recently the amount of literature covering biological effects of magnetic fields has been rapidly increasing By now it has grown to such an extent that it can no longer be covered in one volume Most reviews specialize and focus on particular aspects and or types of fields or effects For example the book edited by MARET et al 1986 gives an overview on biological effects of steady magnetic fields MISAKIAN et al 1993 reviewed those of extremely low frequency magnetic fields focusing on in vitro effects BERNHARD 1992 reported on electromagnetic smog in view of possible effects on human health and well being and a series of papers edited by AMEMIYA 1994 summarizes Japanese research on effects of electromagnetic fields ranging from extremely low to ultra high frequencies TENFORDE 1979 and ADEY 1981 summarized and discussed tissue interactions REITER 1993a neuroendocrine and neurochemical changes associated with various kinds of electromagnetic fields The book edited by KIRSCHVINK et al

Perceiving in Depth, Volume 2: Stereoscopic Vision Ian P. Howard, Brian J. Rogers, 2012-01-27

The three volume work *Perceiving in Depth* is a sequel to *Binocular Vision and Stereopsis* and to *Seeing in Depth* both by Ian P Howard and Brian J Rogers This work is much broader in scope than the previous books and includes mechanisms of depth perception by all senses including aural electrosensory organs and the somatosensory system Volume 1 reviews sensory coding psychophysical and analytic procedures and basic visual mechanisms Volume 2 reviews stereoscopic vision Volume 3 reviews all mechanisms of depth perception other than stereoscopic vision The three volumes are extensively illustrated and referenced and provide the most detailed review of all aspects of perceiving the three dimensional world Volume 2 addresses stereoscopic vision in cats and primates including humans It begins with an account of the physiology of stereoscopic mechanisms It then deals with binocular rivalry binocular summation binocular masking and the interocular transfer of visual effects such as the motion aftereffect and visual learning The geometry of the region in binocular space that creates fused images the horopter is discussed in some detail Objects outside the horopter produce images with binocular disparities that are used for stereoscopic vision Two chapters provide accounts of mechanisms that bring the images into binocular register and of stimulus tokens that are used to detect binocular disparities Another chapter discusses cyclopean effects such as cyclopean illusions cyclopean motion and binocular direction that are seen only with binocular vision Stereoacuity is the smallest depth interval that can be detected Methods of measuring stereoacuity and factors that influence it are discussed Two chapters deal with the various types of binocular disparity and the role of each type in stereoscopic vision Another chapter deals with visual effects such as figure perception motion perception and whiteness perception that are affected by the relative distances of stimuli The spatiotemporal aspects of stereoscopic vision including the Pulfrich stereomotion effect are reviewed The volume ends with an account of techniques used to create stereoscopic displays and of the applications of stereoscopy

The Creative South Andrea Aciri,Peter Sharrock,2022-08-29 This edited volume programmatically reconsiders the creative contribution of the littoral and insular regions of Maritime Asia to shaping new paradigms in the Buddhist and Hindu art and architecture of the mediaeval Asian world Far from being a mere southern conduit for the maritime circulation of Indic religions in the period from ca the 7th to the 14th century those regions transformed across mainland and island polities the rituals icons and architecture that embodied these religious insights with a dynamism that often eclipsed the established cultural centres in Northern India Central Asia and mainland China This collective body of work brings together new research aiming to recalibrate the importance of these innovations in art and architecture thereby highlighting the cultural creativity of the monsoon influenced Southern rim of the Asian landmass Although Maritime Asia in mediaeval times was not as densely populated as the agrarian hinterland Asia s coasts were highly urbanized The region from southern India to south China was a heterogeneous blend of cultures leavened with a strong interest in trade This cosmopolitan society afforded plentiful opportunities for artists to find patrons and develop individual styles and aesthetic sensibilities In the bustling ports of Asia s south coast rulers sought to embellish their prestige and attract foreign merchants by sponsoring the development of monumental complexes and centres of learning and debate These educational institutions attracted teachers from all over Asia and in their cloisters they developed new intellectual frameworks which were reflected in works of art and architecture Scholars moved frequently by sea influencing and being influenced by other foreigners such as Japanese and central Asians who were also attracted to these places This very variety has hindered scholarly research in the past This volume contributes to the endeavour to show how Maritime Asia was not an incoherent jumble of misunderstood influences from better known

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Exploring The Earth: Geography Textbooks For Icse Middle School - Class Vi , World-maps for Finding the Direction and Distance to Mecca David King, 2021-09-06 Two remarkable Iranian world maps were discovered in 1989 and 1995 Both are made of brass and date from 17th century Iran Mecca is at the centre and a highly sophisticated longitude and latitude grid enables the user to determine the direction and distance to Mecca for anywhere in the world between Andalusia and China Prior to the discovery of these maps it was thought that such cartographic grids were conceived in Europe ca 1910 This richly illustrated book presents an overview of the ways in which Muslims over the centuries have determined the sacred direction towards Mecca qibla and then describes the two world maps in detail The author shows that the geographical data derives from a 15th century Central Asian source and that the mathematics underlying the grid was developed in 9th century Baghdad

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
