Answer 1: $0.25 = \frac{25}{100} = \frac{1}{4}$

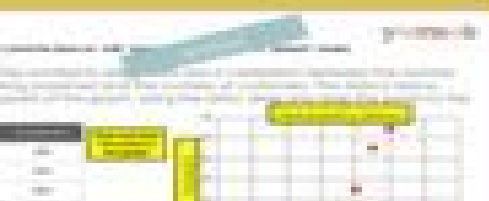
Answer 2: $0.25 = \frac{1}{4}$
