Quinton, 2019-03-07 Originally published in 1973 In this systematic treatise Anthony Quinton examines the concept of substance a philosophical refinement of the everyday notion of a thing Four distinct but not unconnected problems about substance are identified what accounts for the individuality of a thing what confers identity on a thing what is the relation between a thing and its appearances and what kind of thing is fundamental in the sense that its existence is logically independent of that of any other kind of thing In Part 1 the first two problems are discussed while in Part 2 the third and fourth are considered Part 3 examines four kinds of thing that have been commonly held to be in some way non material abstract entities the unobservable entities of scientific theory minds and their states and finally values The author argues that theoretical entities and mental states are in fact material He gives a linguistic account of universals and necessary truths and advances a naturalistic theory of value

The National Review, 1885 *The Cosmological Argument from Plato to Leibniz* William Lane Craig, 1980-06-18 Tai Chen's Inquiry into Goodness Chung-Ying Cheng, 2019-03-31 From Sung times and throughout the Ming period one of the dominant philosophies of China had been a dualistic rationalism thought to be firmly grounded on the classics Tai Chen 1723-1777 was a scholar and philosopher during the Ch'ing period a time when China produced few philosophic thinkers He was the greatest of these and his views are embodied chiefly in *Yuan Shan* and in *Meng Tzu tzu yi shu cheng* In place of the prevailing Sung dualism Tai Chen propounded a rationalistic monism seldom before insinuated in a Chinese philosophy He declines to accept current dogmas and preferred to seek his own truths His commentaries opposed the time honored interpretations of Chu Hsi and he discredited them on purely philosophical grounds But with few disciples to carry on his teachings he was virtually forgotten or ignored in China for more than a hundred years after his death It was not until early in the present century with China under the pressures of Western aggression and internal disorders that Tai Chen's nearness to Western thought was rediscovered and his important role in the history of philosophy recognized Curiously this first of China's Western oriented philosophers even today remains little known in the West and his major writings largely untranslated
