Adorno According to Nicholls Blumenberg's theory of myth can only be understood in relation to the human sciences since it emerges from a speculative hypothesis concerning the emergence of the earliest human beings For Blumenberg myth was originally a cultural adaptation that constituted the human attempt to deal with anxieties concerning the threatening forces of nature by anthropomorphizing those forces into mythic images In the final two chapters Blumenberg's theory of myth is placed within the post war political context of West Germany Through a consideration of Blumenberg's exchanges with Carl Schmitt as well as by analysing unpublished correspondence and parts of the original Work of Myth manuscript that Blumenberg held back from publication Nicholls shows that Blumenberg's theory of myth also amounted to a reckoning with the legacy of National Socialism
