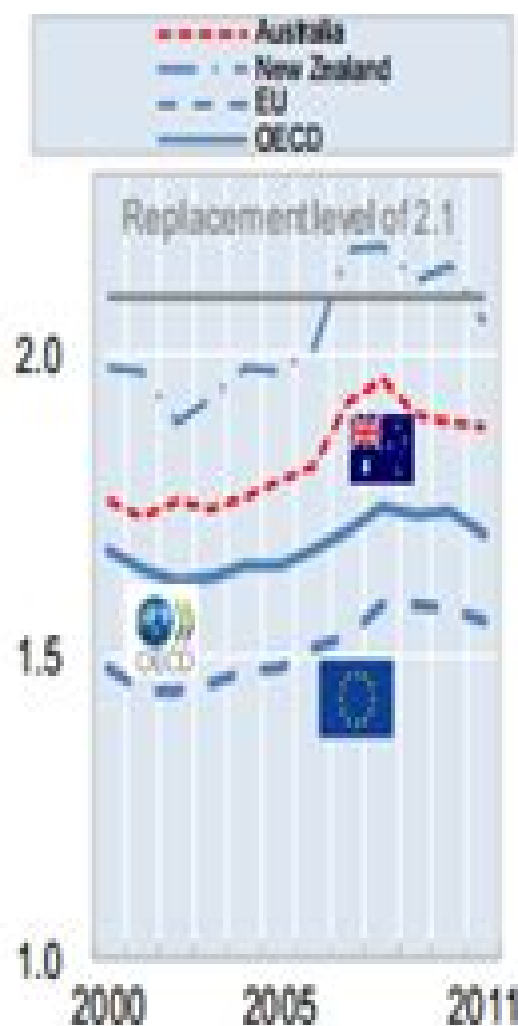


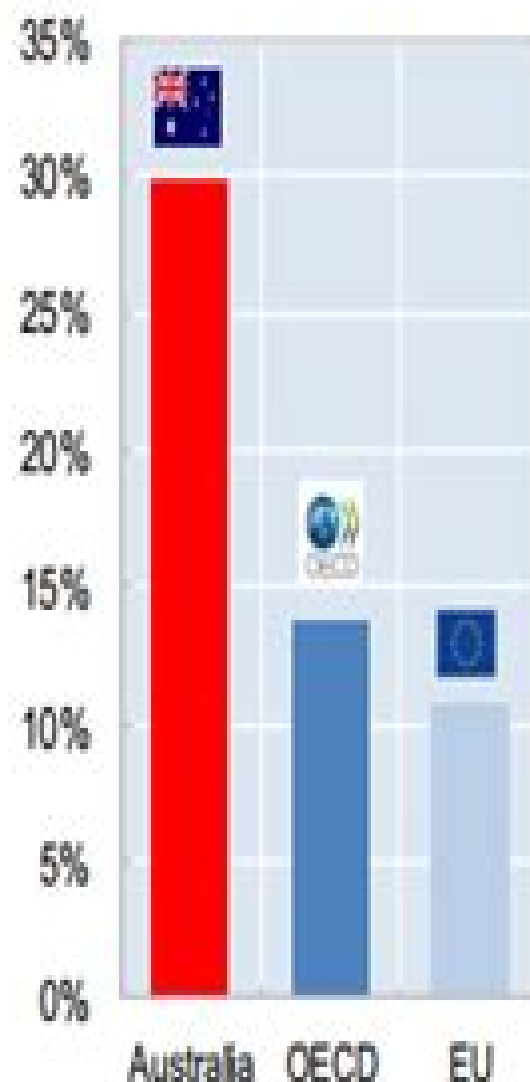
Relative poverty rates
