Peterson, 2021-10-01 Louise Erdrich is one of the most important prolific and widely read contemporary Indigenous writers Here leading scholars analyze the three critically acclaimed recent novels *The Plague of Doves* 2008 *The Round House* 2012 and *LaRose* 2016 that make up what has become known as Erdrich's justice trilogy Set in small towns and reservations of northern North Dakota these three interwoven works bring together a vibrant cast of characters whose lives are shaped by history identity and community Individually and collectively the essays herein illuminate Erdrich's storytelling abilities the complex relations among crime punishment and forgiveness that characterize her work and the Anishinaabe contexts that underlie her presentation of character conflict and community The volume also includes a reader's guide to each novel a glossary and an interview with Erdrich that will aid in readers navigation of the justice novels These timely original and compelling readings make a valuable contribution to Erdrich scholarship and subsequently to the study of Native literature and women's authorship as a whole

The More We Take Kevin Curnin, 2025-04-25 Full of resonance for our imperiled times *The More We Take* tells the story of two tragedies the attempted extermination of indigenous people from North America and relentless extraction from their stolen lands These two kinds of overlapping violence towards one another and towards the planet seem to leave little room for hope And yet at the crossroads of these two desecrations three ordinary Nebraskans aided by

legendary Lakota leaders of the past stumble onto a path that seems to offer a way out redemption from the profound sins of the past and hope for a future in which love not violence takes center stage Blending genres *The More We Take* moves back and forth in time from the genocidal campaign of the U S Army against Indigenous people of the High Plains in the 1880 s to relentless extraction from their stolen lands today Clete Bauer is a surveyor searching for himself A fifth generation Nebraskan his job is to scrutinize the land and advise people on how to improve it But lately especially when he s with his 10 year old niece C J he s been worrying about what we are spoiling the land and the irreplaceable groundwater beneath it and how long we have before the American Heartland reverts to the American Desert Through painful but redemptive spiritual journeys Clete his sister Kathy and his partner Irene a Lakota nurse heal internal traumas and band together to protect what remains of the prairie and the sacred but depleted Ogallala Aquifer But they are outgunned opposed by apathy and racism and Big Agriculture in the form of the self righteous ChemStar Corporation The tide starts to turn when they are joined by legendary Lakota Chiefs of the past like Crazy Horse and Red Cloud who gradually reappear on the Plains to join this unlikely new resistance As a natural resources council meets in Nebraska to protect power and wealth the Sky Council organizes elsewhere watching Clete s small band get stronger Clete learns to leave violence behind Kathy finds a wild spirituality that the church failed to provide And Irene finally forgives herself for leaving her family on the Pine Ridge Reservation The Sky Council itself gets stronger when the chiefs are joined by creative women leaders of the past truth seekers and storytellers like Zitkala Sa and Josephine Waggoner Dreams and visions accompany these intertwined journeys which culminate in a magical final scene in which the resources council and Sky Council face off and the ominous administrative hall where the battle for the future of the new Midwest takes place is overwhelmed by a wild prairie that reclaims its rightful place and opens a mystical path to a sustainable tomorrow [Louise Erdrich](#) Deborah L. situates Native identity among theories of diaspora cosmopolitanism and transnationalism by examining urban narratives such as those written by Sherman Alexie Janet Campbell Hale Louise Erdrich and Susan Power along with the work of filmmakers and artists In these stories Native peoples navigate new surroundings find and reformulate community and maintain and redefine Indian identity in the postrelocation era These narratives illuminate the changing relationship between urban Indigenous peoples and their tribal nations and territories and the ways in which new cosmopolitan bonds both reshape and are interpreted by tribal identities Though the majority of American Indigenous populations do not reside on reservations these spaces regularly define discussions and literature about Native citizenship and identity Meanwhile conversations about the shift to urban settings often focus on elements of dispossession subjectivity and assimilation Furlan takes a critical look at Indigenous fiction from the last three decades to present a new way of looking at urban experiences one that explains mobility and relocation as a form of resistance In these stories Indian bodies are not bound by state imposed borders or confined to Indian Country as it is traditionally conceived Furlan demonstrates that cities have always been Indian land and Indigenous peoples have always been cosmopolitan and urban

Milne,2021-07-01 How does contemporary literature contend with the power and responsibility of authorship particularly when considering marginalized groups How have the works of multiethnic authors challenged the notion that writing and authorship are neutral or universal In Novel Subjects Leah Milne offers a new way to look at multicultural literature by focusing on scenes of writing in contemporary works by authors with marginalized identities These scenes she argues establish authorship as a form of radical self care a term we owe to Audre Lorde who defines self care as self preservation and an act of political warfare In engaging in this battle the works discussed in this study confront limitations on ethnicity and nationality wrought by the institutionalization of multiculturalism They also focus on identities whose mere presence on the cultural landscape is often perceived as vindictive or willful Analyzing recent texts by Carmen Maria Machado Louise Erdrich Ruth Ozeki Toni Morrison and more Milne connects works across cultures and nationalities in search of reasons for this recent trend of depicting writers as characters in multicultural texts Her exploration uncovers fiction that embrace unacceptable or marginalized modes of storytelling such as plagiarism historical revisions jokes and lies as well as inauthentic invisible and unexceptional subjects These works ultimately reveal a shared goal of expanding the borders of belonging in ethnic and cultural groups and thus add to the ever evolving conversations surrounding both multicultural literature and self care
