include as pt 2 of the Jan issue Medical subject headings *Marine Ecosystem Restoration (MER) - Challenges and New Horizons* Brian Silliman, Avigdor Abelson, Christine Angelini, Gesche Krause, Megan Irene Saunders, Tjisse Van Der Heide, 2023-10-23 Worldwide marine ecosystems have been lost and degraded due to anthropogenic disturbances For example oyster reefs have declined by at least 85% coral reefs by 19% seagrasses by 29% North American salt marshes by 42% and mangroves by 35% from the early 19th century Deepwater reefs and deep sea vents are not immune and have also been reduced in extent in many areas Factors driving these losses include habitat destruction pollution invasive species overfishing trawling mining and more recently climate change effects such as ocean warming species range changes and acidification These habitat declines are occurring at a time when marine waters are being used at or near their maximum productive capacity to meet the contemporary needs of an ever increasing human population Because coastal and marine ecosystems generate some of the richest biodiversity hotspots on Earth and provide critical ecosystem services including storm protection fisheries production and carbon storage over 1 billion US dollars have been spent globally in an attempt to halt and reverse observed declines Early conservation efforts aimed at protecting these valuable and threatened habitats focused on reducing human impacts and physical stressors However with habitat degradation continuing and sometimes increasing in rate it is now clear conservation alone will not be sufficient to protect and reestablish coastal ecosystems Habitat restoration although in existence for many decades has recently been elevated as a new primary strategy to stem and even reverse coastal habitat loss The call for increasing investment in restoration efforts has emerged with significant advances in propagule rearing and dispersion of habitat forming organisms e g oysters seagrasses corals In addition restoration resources are increasingly allocated by governments and or large corporations with the aim to for example fix past landscape engineering efforts that had unintended environmental consequences Such investments are being made to i provide jobs for those unemployed during economic downturns ii restore ecosystems destroyed by natural disasters and stressors iii increase coastal defense in response to increased frequency of intense storms and or iv compensate for pollution and development driven habitat degradation Conservation practitioners have traditionally been skeptical to invest heavily in restoration at large scales because of the high cost per area 10 000 5 000 000 US ha for coastal vs 500 5 000 US ha for terrestrial systems to replant coastal ecosystems and or the high chance that the restored ecosystems will not live long e g outplanted corals For restoration to be effective and employed as a primary method of coastal conservation at relevant scales we must improve its efficiency lower costs and rapidly share and incorporate advances One crucial step will be to identify when and where restoration attempts have been carried out according to state of art ecological theory and gauge their success Another is generating synthesis studies that focus both within and across ecosystems to identify efficiencies adaptations and innovations Work that shows theoretical and methodological innovations in specific ecosystems as well as across systems will be critical to pushing all fields of MER forward Although there is rapidly increasing interest and

investment the field of marine ecosystem restoration is just beginning to undergo synthesis Therefore the aim of this Research Topic is to bring together research contributions to help address this synthesis need provide a spotlight for recent innovations enhance our understanding of successful methods in marine ecosystem restoration and promote integration of ecological sociological and engineering theory into restoration practices *Conditions Regarding U.N. Bisson,2019-08-16 Wine yeast and bacteria have been extensively characterized in terms of physiological and metabolic traits largely in pure culture analyses Winemaking practices derived from this basic knowledge have undoubtedly improved wine quality Phylogenetic studies and genome comparisons in extensive collections have revealed the processes of evolution and adaptation of the two main microbial species *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* and *Oenococcus oeni* present in wine However grapes and grape juice contain a variety of microorganisms and these principal agents of fermentation are in fact part of a complex microbial community that evolves dynamically in a special niche Thanks to the new methods of analysis the complexity of the microbiota can be measured in any sample of must or wine In addition there is greater appreciation of diversity within the main species present in wine Intraspecific diversity has been evaluated in yeast and bacteria species and strains can be typed even in the mixture of selected or indigenous strains Descriptions of microbial profiles in all the regions of the world suggest that the microbiota is a significant element of terroir or regional signature It is no longer enough to simply describe what is

present It is important to consider evolution physiology and metabolism taking into account microbial interactions within the community Research in wine microbiology has also expanded our understanding of the participation and role of non Saccharomyces organisms in winemaking and refined knowledge on microbial spoilage However it is challenging to go from the simple description of these phenomena to their interpretation The greatest difficulty lies in analyzing the functioning of the extraordinary complex system of yeast and bacteria present during different stages of the fermentation Interactions in the very particular environment of fermenting grape induce alternations of relative populations dominances and declines with subsequent impacts on wine composition Some mechanisms have been identified or suggested but much remains to be done The recent advent of inoculation with non Saccharomyces in oenological practice sometimes leading to inconstant results reflects the profound gaps that exist in knowledge of the complexity of fermentation and wine microbial ecosystems Understanding how the microbial community works is expected to provide a sound basis before using fermentation helpers and starters taking into account the indigenous microbiota It will also aid in monitoring and understanding native or uninoculated fermentations that rely on the complex interactions of grape winery and fermentation biota for their aroma and flavor profile The aim of this Research Topic was to bring together current knowledge on several key aspects of wine microorganism biology i Evolution co evolution of yeasts and bacteria in their process of domestication and adaptation to the oenological niche ii Mechanisms of interactions between species and strains both on grapes and in grape must iii Metabolism and physiology of yeast and bacteria in interactions with each other and with the environment considering to what extent expected objectives typicity lower alcohol etc can be reached by using selected strains iv Development of novel technologies or approaches for the assessment of changes in a dynamic microbial community and the linking of such changes to wine flavor and aroma properties v Diversity ecology physiology and metabolism of *B. bruxellensis* Damage from this spoilage agent is not effectively prevented because we do not fully understand the biology of this species particularly in interaction with other yeast and bacteria Each chapter presents advances in these areas of study Research in wine microbiology particularly in the wine microbiome and its impacts on wine composition is enhancing our understanding of the complexities and dynamics of microbial food and beverage ecosystems

Reid,2009-08-21 A critique of selectionism and the proposal of an alternate theory of emergent evolution that is causally sufficient for evolutionary biology Natural selection is commonly interpreted as the fundamental mechanism of evolution Questions about how selection theory can claim to be the all sufficient explanation of evolution often go unanswered by today s neo Darwinists perhaps for fear that any criticism of the evolutionary paradigm will encourage creationists and proponents of intelligent design In Biological Emergences Robert Reid argues that natural selection is not the cause of evolution He writes that the causes of variations which he refers to as natural experiments are independent of natural selection indeed he suggests natural selection may get in the way of evolution Reid proposes an alternative theory to explain how emergent novelties are generated and under what conditions they can overcome the resistance of natural selection He suggests that what causes innovative variation causes evolution and that these phenomena are environmental as well as organismal After an extended critique of selectionism Reid constructs an emergence theory of evolution first examining the evidence in three causal arenas of emergent evolution symbiosis association evolutionary physiology behavior and developmental evolution Based on this evidence of causation he proposes some working hypotheses examining mechanisms and processes common to all three arenas and arrives at a theoretical framework that accounts for generative mechanisms and emergent qualities Without selectionism Reid argues evolutionary innovation can more easily be integrated into a general thesis Finally Reid proposes a biological synthesis of rapid emergent evolutionary phases and the prolonged dynamically stable non evolutionary phases imposed by natural selection
