The persona of the knowledge seeker was constructed by drawing together mind and matter thought and feeling And so where the Enlightenment thinker is generally associated with reason truth telling and social and political reform the Enlightenment is also known for its valorisation of emotion During the period intellectual pursuits were envisioned as having a distinctly embodied and emotional aspect The body of sensibility encompassed these apparently disparate strands and was associated with terms including sentimental sentiment sense sensation and sympathy The Specter of Skepticism in the Age of Enlightenment Anton M.
