COURT VOIDS ABORTION LAWS

Worst Air Crash Ever; 180 Killed

LAOS, (UPI) — A
jetliner carrying 180
passengers from a
pilgrimage to Mecca crashed in
southern Vietnam Monday, killing
180 of the 191 persons
aboard in the worst single air
disaster in history, airport
officials said.

Airport authorities said a total
of 23 persons, including the pilot,
had not yet been recovered, re-
maining the crash.

The officials said the Boeing
747 jet came off the runway in
high winds as it was landing at
Kam airport and burst into
flames.

In the worst process air dis-
aster, 170 persons were killed
when a Japanese jumbo
crashed near Saigon's Dom-
monville airport on Oct. 15, 1970.

South Viets Suffer Big War Setback

SAMSON (UPI) — South Viet-
nam forces have suffered a
major defeat in the last few
days, with two army battalions
captured and not to planes and
armor taken, especially an-
timated southwest of Saigon.

Field reports said at least 30
armored cars, some of them mount-
ed, had arrived back to govern-
ment bases in the last two days.
These had been given safe re-
turn passes by the Communists
after agreeing to leave away
their weapons.

surrender. The two battalions, which apparently
had been on enemy traps on two
days. The government has ad-
vised its forces in the area to
be alert and not to trust the
troops.
