B	Type II	Organisms equally likely to die at any point throughout their life.	Small animals (ex. Robins!) Predating birds (larks)
C	Type III	Organisms have many offspring and do not invest much care in them. They die early on.	Fish Small insects Small plants

Type of distribution	Picture of distribution	Why use this pattern?
Clumped	 	VERY COMMON Safety in numbers, social interactions, mating and caring for young, resources are clumped.
Dispersed	 	Scarcity of resources, territoriality
Random	 	VERY COMMON It's random (ex. Robins) because they breed with their adult partners, so random (ex. Robins).
