The LAFA data provide daily estimates of the per capita availability amounts adjusted for loss e.g. in pounds, ounces, grams, and gallons as appropriate, calories, and food pattern equivalents i.e. servings of the five major food groups: fruit, vegetables, grains, meat, and dairy, available for consumption, plus the amounts of added sugars and sweeteners and added fats and oils available for consumption. This fiscal year, as part of its initiative to systematically review all of its major data series, ERS decided to review the FADS data system.
