Jenny Edkins, Poststructuralism and International Relations: Bringing the Political Back In (London: Lynne Rienner, 1999, 170 pp., £39.95 hbk.).

Poststructuralism and International Relations aims at bringing discussions of the concept of 'the political' into the theoretical debate within International Relations. It suggests that 'realignment and re-examination of the subjectivity' would challenge International Relations as it reassesses "the political" itself (p. xi). This aim is approached by looking at mainly three important philosophical traditions: poststructuralist, deconstructivist, and psychoanalytical, focusing particularly on the writings of Michel Foucault, Jacques Derrida, Jacques Lacan, and Slavoj Žižek. Thus, follows a discussion of the possibility of articulating a perspective which thinks about the question of the political.

In the first chapter, Edkins focuses on the differentiation between 'politics and the political'. The former refers to 'depoliticised' and normalised activities within given social structures, while 'the political' refers to the overarching social framework in which politics takes place and in which other social spheres are delineated. The central issues of the book—depoliticisation, sovereignty, and subjectivity—are used to bring about the question of the political in terms of 'time, essence, and language'.

In chapter two, the reader is introduced to four decentrings of the Enlightenment subject, which Edkins locates in the Cartesian subjectivity. She analyses different challenges from a variety of positions: linguistic (Saussure), Unconscious (Sigmund Freud), Feminist (Luce Irigiray), and social (Karl Marx). These positions are then developed from the perspectives of Foucault, Derrida, Lacan, and Žižek.

Chapter three deals with Foucault's writings and the way in which he problematises the Enlightenment subject. Edkins demonstrates the possibility of questioning, and thus denaturalising, the relationship between an assigned subject position and politics, whereby the subject is repoliticised along with the knowledge
