

"The Great Gatsby" Essay Topics

Directions: Choose one of the essay topics below and compose an essay. The essay should be a minimum of three typed pages (not counting the Works Cited page) and should follow the same guidelines you used for your first essay. ("Steps to Writing an Essay" and "Formula for Writing an Essay").

*If you would prefer to write on a different topic, you may do so if you get the topic approved by me. (You can just send me a text telling me what you want to write about, and we can discuss it).

Essay Topic #1

Analyze Gatsby's coming of age throughout the novel. What fears and emotions does he experience as he grows from a boy in North Dakota, a teenager, a soldier, and a successful adult? How do his attitudes change as he develops from a young boy into a young man? Cite examples of the character changes Gatsby experiences from each stage of his life.

Essay Topic #2

One of the main themes in the novel is the pursuit of the American Dream. Explain the similarities and differences in how Daisy, Nick, Tom, and Gatsby try to achieve their individual version of the American Dream. Which of the characters was the most successful in achieving the American Dream?

Essay Topic #3

Evaluate the elements of cause and effect in this story using examples from the novel. Choose three events from the story that cause change in Gatsby's life. How does Gatsby react to the events and their effects? How does he change emotionally in his own life and in his attitude toward Daisy?

Essay Topic #4

The theme of Appearance and Reality is constant throughout the novel. Analyze the lives of Gatsby, Tom, and Daisy regarding appearances and reality. Explain how each characters' outward actions hides the reality behind their superficiality. Contrast the superficial lives of these characters with the honesty of Nick Carraway. Analyze the resolution of the story as it relates to each of the main characters in the novel. Explain the metamorphosis each character experiences in the final three chapters. Describe how Nick's words "So we beat on, boats against the current, borne back ceaselessly into the past.", relate to Jay Gatsby, Daisy, Tom, and Nick.
