Essay Topic #1

How do his attitudes change as he develops from a young boy into a young man? Cite examples of the character changes Gatsby experiences from each stage of his life.

Essay Topic #2

One of the main themes in the novel is the pursuit of the American Dream. Explain the similarities and differences in how Daisy, Nick, Tom, and Gatsby try to achieve their individual version of the American Dream. Which of the characters was the most successful in achieving the American Dream?

Essay Topic #3

Evaluate the elements of cause and effect in this story using examples from the novel. Choose three events from the story that cause change in Gatsby's life. How does Gatsby react to the events and their effects? How does he change emotionally in his own life and in his attitude toward Daisy?

The theme of Appearance and Reality is constant throughout the novel. Analyze the lives of Gatsby, Tom, and Daisy regarding appearances and reality.
