Brent, 2010-04-06 Thyroid function tests are utilized by essentially all medical practitioners across every clinical setting in patients from newborns to the elderly They are the most frequently measured endocrine tests The sensitive thyrotropin TSH assay reflects thyroid hormone feedback to the pituitary and is diagnostic of both thyroid h mone excess as well as deficiency The log linear relationship between serum TSH and thyroxine concentrations means that small changes in serum thyroxine are amplified by changes in serum TSH The availability of the sensitive TSH assay in essentially all clinical laboratories has improved and simplified the assessment of thyroid function for the diagnosis of thyroid disease and to monitor treatment Serum free thyroxine and thyrotropin
