missions stressed sacramental confession and the practice became a widespread routine in American Catholic life After the Second Vatican Council the practice of sacramental confession declined suddenly The post Vatican II history of penance influenced by the Council s reforms and by changing American moral and cultural values reveals a major shift in penitential theology moving from an emphasis on confession to emphasis on reconciliation Catholics make up about a quarter of the American population and thus changes in the practice of penance had an impact on the wider society In the fifty years since the Council penitential language has been overshadowed increasingly by the language of conflict and controversy In today s social and political climate Confession may help Americans understand how far their society has departed from the penitential language of the earlier American tradition and consider the advantages and disadvantages of such a departure
