2500 noms propres devenus communs Georges Lebouc, 2014-09-15 Si on vous demande d'o vient le mot mansarde vous répondrez coup sûr de Mansart Tout comme la poubelle rappelle le nom d'un préfet de police parisien et guillotine celui d'un médecin qui préconisa cet instrument par humanité C'est une forme de gloire que de passer la postérité en laissant son nom à une chose comme la mousseline originaire de Mossoul en Irak un animal comme l'angora qui nous vient d'Ankara un trait de caractère comme tartuffe ou un terme sportif comme le derby En cherchant tous azimuts on s'aperçoit qu'il y a des centaines de mots qui dérivent de noms propres et ce dans tous les domaines Nous en avons recensés 2500 dans cet ouvrage qui pourtant ne prétend pas l'exhaustivité Vous n'emploierez plus les termes ampères joules watts et autres coulombs sans songer que ces appellations étranges rappellent les noms de savants et lorsque vous parcourrez les allées d'un jardin vous songerez aux grands botanistes qui ont donné leur nom au bignon camélia fuchsia etc L'ensemble est complété par des tableaux qui regroupent quelques uns de ces mots par affinité noms de monnaies de chiens de chevaux ou de chats de vins ou de fromages qui tous ont pour origine un nom propre propos de l'auteur En une quarantaine de livres Georges Lebouc a surtout abordé les langues qu'il a enseignées comme l'italien ou l'espagnol ou qu'il a suées avec le lait maternel comme le bruxellois sans oublier le français langue de ses ancêtres Depuis quelques années il se consacre surtout à l'histoire anecdotique de Bruxelles sa ville natale mais revient à la linguistique avec un ouvrage sur les noms propres devenus communs *Comment les mots changent de sens par É. Littré avec un avant-propos et des notes par Michel Bréal* Emile Littré, 1888

L'appellativisation du prénom Vincent Balnat, 2018-03-26 Cette étude est consacrée au passage du prénom au nom commun en allemand et en français et aux mots qui en résultent les dénomastiques de prénoms tels que Metze prostituée Hanswurst guignol catin et Jean Foutre Couvrant la période du XII^e au XXI^e siècle ce travail repose sur une importante base de données les items tant issus pour l'essentiel de dictionnaires historiques Il fait d'abord le point sur l'état de la recherche relative aux dénomastiques en allemand et en français sur la notion de prototype du dénomastique de prénom et sur les aspects sémantiques propres ce type de mots L'auteur d'ailleurs énumère ensuite les principaux facteurs linguistiques et extralinguistiques qui ont pu favoriser l'émergence d'une signification lexicale avant de classer les items collectés de manière à faire apparaître deux caractéristiques particulièrement nettes de ces dénomastiques savoir la forte polysémie et la tendance à la péjoration En conclusion le travail présente quelques réflexions propos de l'évolution passée et présente de ce phénomène linguistique bien particulier qu'est

l'appellativisation du prénom dans les deux langues Le roman d'Héliopolis Amélie d'Arschot Schoonhoven, 2018-04-13 L'auteur nous plonge dans les coulisses de la Grande Exposition universelle de 1900 Paris Amélie d'Arschot fait revivre sous sa plume animée les personnages clés de cet extraordinaire projet le roi Léopold II sans qui les intérêts belges en Égypte n'auraient pu se développer les hommes d'affaires de même que les architectes de talent Ceux-ci ont réalisé une ville sublime sur le plan architectural Héliopolis fut cependant bien plus qu'une superbe ville elle a représenté tout un art de vivre et un esprit de tolérance

rance permettant aux différents cultes de se côtoyer. Un tableau vivant d'une époque vivante et une parfaite maîtrise du sujet rendent le récit captivant. Au travers des lignes se dessine comme des hiéroglyphes la passion qui prouve l'auteur pour l'Égypte.

EXTRAIT Le sujet d'Héliopolis fait partie de ma vie puisque mon arrière-grand-mère Eva d'Arschot Schoonhoven était la fille de Boghos Nubar Pacha associé de douard Empain dans la Cairo Electric Railways Heliopolis Oases Company. douard Empain était le président et son ami Boghos Nubar le vice-président. Ils ont acquis ensemble les premiers deux mille cinq cents hectares dans le désert en vue d'y ériger une nouvelle ville. J'avais douze ans lorsque mon arrière-grand-mère est morte et je garde d'elle un souvenir très précis car lui rendre visite était pour moi pénible dans ce monde envoûté et étrange qui représente l'Orient. Les persiennes de ses fenêtres étaient toujours un peu tirées pour filtrer la lumière crue du dehors et se voiler en quelque sorte de l'intérieur. C'était l'Orient des parfums et des songes avec des statues silencieuses qui l'entouraient telle une garde rapprochée.

Le confédéralisme, une dangereuse illusion. De Gaulle et la Belgique Catherine Lanneau, Francis Depagie, 2016-01-15 Le premier ouvrage sur l influence politique du g n ral de Gaulle en Belgique Pr s de quarante cinq ans apr s sa mort la figure du g n ral de Gaulle demeure pour beaucoup une r f rence incontournable sinon un mythe politique bien au del des fronti res fran aises La p riode gaullienne celle des tourbillonnantes ann es 1960 a retenu l attention de nombreux historiens mais peu se sont pench s sur le rapport particulier

entretenu par les Belges et la Belgique avec cette France gaullienne et avec l'image même du Général. Le présent ouvrage issu d'une collaboration entre des historiens universitaires et le Cercle d'études Charles de Gaulle en Belgique entend combler ce vide en rassemblant différentes contributions qui toutes clairont l'homme et son époque d'un jour nouveau. Comment de Gaulle était-il perçu dans les sphères diplomatiques belges ou la Cour de Belgique ? Quels furent réellement les liens entre les militants wallons et les milieux gaullistes ? Quel regard portaient ceux-ci sur la Belgique et sur la Communauté économique européenne ? Eut-il en pleine guerre d'Algérie une OAS belge ? Autant de questions auxquelles ce livre tente d'apporter une réponse. Avec les contributions de Francis Balace, Christoph Brühl, Francis Depagie, Vincent Dujardin, Vincent Genin, Catherine Lanneau et Laurent Warloutzet. Actes de la journée d'études Nouveaux regards sur de Gaulle la période gaullienne et la Belgique 20 avril 2013 Université de Liège. **EXTRAIT** Jusqu'à ce jour aucun ouvrage de synthèse n'a encore été publié sur la Belgique et Charles de Gaulle. Même si ce sujet ne semble pas concerner ce que l'on a coutume d'appeler la grande histoire et si en soi il n'apparaît pas aussi vaste que par exemple de Gaulle et le Québec ou encore de Gaulle et l'Afrique noire, il mérite cependant d'être vu. Ce n'est pas pour des raisons de proximité géographique. Charles de Gaulle le Parisien n'est-il pas né Lille, rue Princesse, chez ses grands-parents Maillot, auxquels il rendit de fréquentes visites durant son enfance ? N'a-t-il pas fréquenté avant d'entrer à Saint-Cyr un établissement jadis de Antoing dans le Hainaut ? N'a-t-il pas en août 1914 été blessé à Dinant ? Ces attaches belges du Général ont souvent été mises en évidence, surtout la libération par les journalistes locaux, commencer par Charles d'Ydewalle, dont la propre grand-mère habitait un immeuble lillois du 91 rue Royale, l'angle de la rue Princesse. Avoir connu de Gaulle avant qu'il ne devienne un mythe est un privilège rare dont d'Ydewalle tirait manifestement une certaine fierté. Dans son ouvrage *La Cour et la Ville*, il insistait pesamment sur les qualités qu'il avait tirées de celles chez de Gaulle. **A PROPOS DE L'AUTEUR** Catherine Lanneau, chargée de cours à l'Université de Liège, est spécialiste des relations franco-belges au XX^e siècle.
