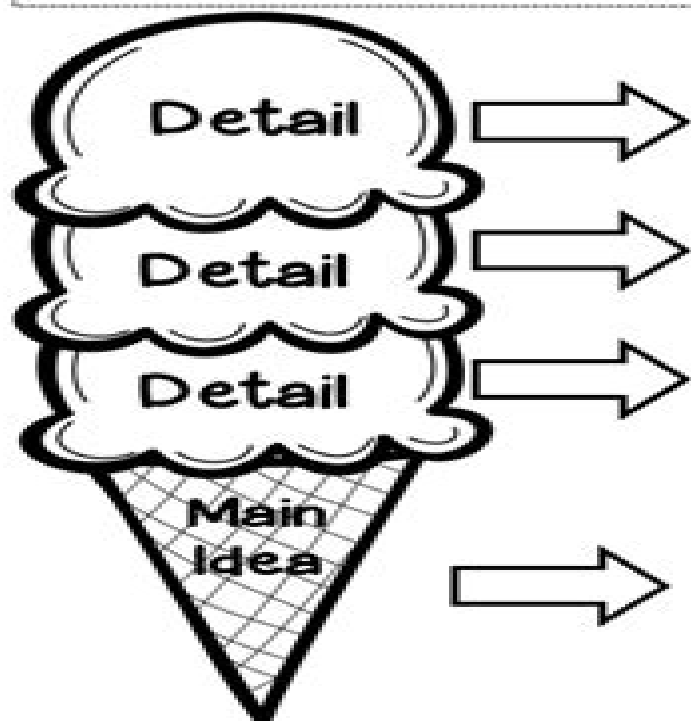


Main Idea & Details
