Arrange the steps to solve this system of linear equations in the correct sequence.

$$x + y = -2$$

$$2x - 3y = -9$$

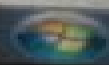
## Tiles

Subtract  $3x + 3y = -6$  (obtained in step 1) from  $2x - 3y = -9$  (given) to solve for  $x$ .

Substitute the value of  $x$  in the first equation ( $x + y = -2$ ) to get  $y = 1$ .

The solution for the system of equations is  $(-3, 1)$ .
