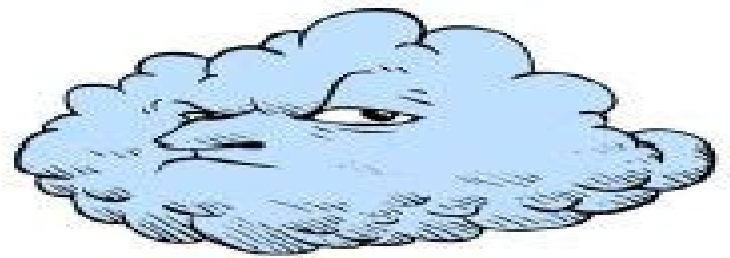


Personification (pronounced: PER-son-if-i-kay-shun) is when a writer makes a non-human object or idea seem like a person. How many times is personification used in this poem?

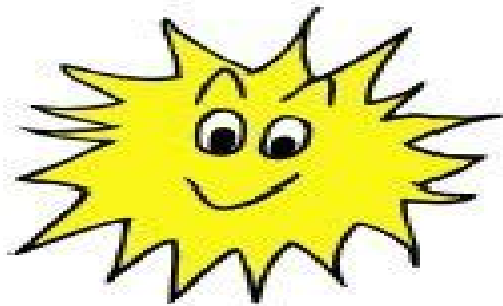
Personification
