- During the Gulf War, the Patriot missile defense system was deployed in Israel on Israeli battleships.
- The Patriot spent a major amount of money on missiles and related technologies.
- It was made initially and yet unable to hit its targets right, and breaking up its own system throughout the war.
- On February 25, 1991, the defense system failed to hit a Soviet Scud missile.
- The missile hit an army barracks and killed 28 soldiers.

What went wrong?

- The main clock was software failure.
- The software used a 24-bit fixed-point number for hours that passed time.
- The main loop was not updated as required.
- **Why not: 1.100 for representing accuracy in seconds that must be binary?**
2.5 for hours that is a representing number. And since hours 24 is 24 is a representing number.
2.100 for fixed 24 is a representing number.
