While Bryan never amassed a wide enough constituency to propel his cause into the White House America's stubborn attachment to gold persisted wreaking so much havoc that FDR in order to help rescue the moribund Depression economy ordered a ban on private ownership of gold in 1933. In fact so entrenched was the belief that gold should uphold the almighty dollar it was not until 1973 that Richard Nixon ordered that the dollar be delinked from any relation to gold completely overhauling international economic policy and cementing the dollar's global significance. More intriguing is the fact that America's exuberant fascination with gold has continued long after Nixon's historic decree as in the profusion of late night television ads that appeal to goldbug speculators that proliferate even into the present. One Nation Under Gold reveals as much about American economic history as it does about the sectional divisions that continue to cleave our nation ultimately becoming a unique history about economic irrationality and its influence on the American psyche.

Investing in Science Massimo Florio, 2019-10-15 A proposal for using cost benefit analysis to evaluate the socioeconomic impact of public investment in large scientific projects.
