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Protest and Resistance in the Tourist City Claire Colomb, Johannes Novy, 2016-07-01 Across the globe from established tourist destinations such as Venice or Prague to less traditional destinations in both the global North and South there is mounting evidence that points to an increasing politicization of the topic of urban tourism In some cities residents and other stakeholders take issue with the growth of tourism as such as well as the negative impacts it has on their cities while in others particular forms and effects of tourism are contested or deplored In numerous settings contestations revolve less around tourism itself than around broader processes policies and forces of urban change perceived to threaten the right to stay put the quality of life or identity of existing urban populations This book for the first time looks at urban tourism as a source of contention and dispute and analyses what type of conflicts and contestations have emerged around urban tourism in 16 cities across Europe North America South America and Asia It explores the various ways in which community groups residents and other actors have responded to and challenged tourism development in an international and multi disciplinary perspective The title links the largely discrete yet interconnected disciplines of urban studies and tourism studies and draws on approaches and debates from urban sociology urban policy and politics urban geography urban anthropology cultural studies urban design and planning tourism studies and tourism management This ground breaking volume offers new insight into the conflicts and struggles generated by urban tourism and will be of interest to students researchers and academics from the fields of tourism geography planning urban studies development studies anthropology politics and sociology

Official Voter Information Guide, 2006-11 *Hope Is Not a Plan* Thomas Mowle, 2007-03-30 *Hope Is Not a Plan* takes the reader inside the war in Iraq courtesy of participant observers brought there to diagnose the insurgency and develop a get well plan Focusing on the critical months of late 2004 and early 2005 it looks at a slice of the war not previously examined This is not the Beltway story nor the grunt and jarhead story Rather the book looks at the process of taking political and military goals and turning them into action In telling that story *Hope Is Not a Plan* helps explain how Iraq got to where it is today The book compares the reality of what happen in the Green Zone during this period with what history experience and doctrine suggest should have happened Finally it reflects on what can be learned from the experience From the outset the war in Iraq was directed from Washington and executed by troops on the ground Between Washington and the battlefields was the Green Zone a four square mile enclave that hosted the American Embassy annex the Iraqi Reconstruction Management Office the planning policy strategy and communications sections of Headquarters Multi national Force Iraq and the Independent Electoral Commission of Iraq ***Trading with the Enemy*** Hugo Meijer, 2016-02-02 In light of the intertwining logics of military competition and economic interdependence at play in US China relations *Trading with the Enemy* examines how the United States has balanced its potentially conflicting national security and economic interests in its relationship with the People s Republic of China PRC To do so Hugo Meijer investigates a strategically sensitive yet under

explored facet of US China relations the making of American export control policy on military related technology transfers to China since 1979 Trading with the Enemy is the first monograph on this dimension of the US China relationship in the post Cold War Based on 199 interviews declassified documents and diplomatic cables leaked by Wikileaks two major findings emerge from this book First the US is no longer able to apply a strategy of military technology containment of China in the same way it did with the Soviet Union during the Cold War This is because of the erosion of its capacity to restrict the transfer of military related technology to the PRC Secondly a growing number of actors in Washington have reassessed the nexus between national security and economic interests at stake in the US China relationship by moving beyond the Cold War trade off between the two in order to maintain American military preeminence vis vis its strategic rivals By focusing on how states manage the heterogeneous and potentially competing security and economic interests at stake in a bilateral relationship this book seeks to shed light on the evolving character of interstate rivalry in a globalized economy where rivals in the military realm are also economically interdependent

Gillette, 2011-06-28 The traditional theory of urban finance argues against local redistribution of wealth on the assumption that such action is likely to chase away the relatively wealthy leaving only the impoverished behind Nevertheless Clayton P Gillette observes local governments engage in substantial redistribution both to the wealthy and to the poor In this thoughtful book Gillette examines whether recent campaigns to enact living wage ordinances and other local

redistributive programs represent gaps in the traditional theory or political opportunism He then investigates the role of the courts in distinguishing between these explanations The author argues that courts have greater capacity to review local programs than is typically assumed He concludes that when a single interest group dominates the political process judicial intervention to determine a program's legal validity may be appropriate But if the political contest involves competing groups courts should defer to local political judgments

Information Warfare Edwin Leigh Armistead, 2007 In Leigh Armistead's second edited volume on warfare in the Information Age the authors explore the hype over possibilities versus actuality in their analysis of Information Operations IO today First leaders must better understand the informational element of national power and second their sole focus on technology must expand to include IO's physical interconnectivity content and cognitive dimensions Finally the authors urge the United States to use its enormous IO advantage to deal with complex national security issues beyond the Department of Defense for example in swaying global opinion and influencing other populations Armistead and his colleagues set aside the hype and conjecture concerning IO because its real potential is more powerful and comprehensive than currently appreciated In a straightforward format they take practitioners on the path toward a smart and effective way of waging IO While the original claims of bloodless wars or of computer hackers plunging North America into a new dark age of constant electric grid collapses quickly raised awareness of new threats and capabilities in the Information Age these scenarios strain credulity and hamper our understanding of those threats and capabilities This volume corrects this situation grounding IO in the real world and concentrates on its actual challenges capabilities and accomplishments *Information Warfare* will be an indispensable guide and reference work for professionals and students in the fields of national security
