It was important to him also to learn from other officers. So much of the job requires experience. People behave in unpredictable and dangerous ways sometimes, and it is always useful to bear how more experienced officers have coped with things in the past. The office was very sure that the police academy was essential when it comes to tactical writs, but he thought experience and insteading to experiences of others was just as important as the technical skills that are taught in the academy.

When asked what was difficult about the job, the officer mentioned the way that people get out of control. He said that police officers are not able to lose control, and that they have to be fair at all times, and be aware that they are being watched. This was a big
