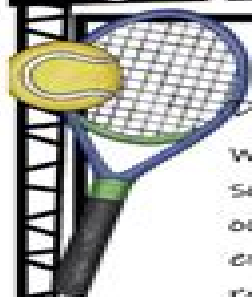


WELCOME BACK
