#### Unit D: Population and Community Dynamics

Students must be able to:

- ☐ Use the Hardy-Weinberg principle to determine allele and genotype frequency in a set of data by using the equations  $p + q = 1$  and  $p^2 + 2pq + q^2 = 1$
- ☐ Explain how mutations and natural selection are at the molecular level and how significant they are over time
- ☐ Correctly apply significant digits when making calculations
- ☐ Explain predator-prey and consumer-producer relationships
- ☐ Define commensalism, mutualism, and parasitism
- ☐ Differentiate between interspecific and intraspecific competition
- ☐ Give examples of defence mechanisms and how they affect predation and competition
- ☐ Explain how population structures may change over time or day as a climax community
- ☐ Define primary and secondary succession
- ☐ Analyse succession patterns over time
- ☐ Calculate change in population size using the formula:  $\Delta N = [\text{natality} + \text{immigration}] - [\text{mortality} + \text{emigration}]$
- ☐ Use formulas to calculate: growth rate, per capita growth rate, and population density
- ☐ Identify a growth pattern as either logistic (S-shaped) or exponential (J-shaped)
- ☐ Explain the difference between open and closed populations
- ☐ Identify a species as r or K selected based on characteristics or reproductive strategies
- ☐ Evaluate how environmental factors can affect population growth
- ☐ Analyse graphical data on r or K selected species
